Main functions: (only support iOS system () "Find" application, Android is not applicable) Instructions for use:

 Tag power on Press the switch button to activate the Tag (there is a short beep beep beep sound).

2. Pairing Tag

Open Apple's "Find" App, click "Devices", then click the device you want to find.

Bring the Tag close to your iPhone, tap the "Items" tab to select "+" and "Tap Other Supported Items".

-Tap Connect. Fill in the "Custom Name" to name your Tag and select an emoticon, tap "Agree" to confirm that the Tag will be linked to your Apple device. tap Done.

3. Enable Lost Mode

-Open "Find" app, tap "Tag", and then tap the name of the lost tag.

-Under "Lost Mode", click "Enable". Follow the on-screen instructions and click "Continue" to enter your contact number or mail address. -Click "Next" to check the information, and then click "Enable" again to complete the setup.

4. Delete Device

-Open Apple's "Find App", tap "Tag" at the bottom of the screen, and then tap the name of the tag you want to remove.

Find "Remove Item" at the bottom of the list, tap "Remove" to finish the operation.

Note: The local unbinding operation of the anti-lost device: press the button 5 times quickly and continuously (the first 4 times you press the button once, there will be a "beep" sound).

5. Factory reset method: Remove the battery, then reinstall it, and repeat this operation five times to restore the factory settings.
