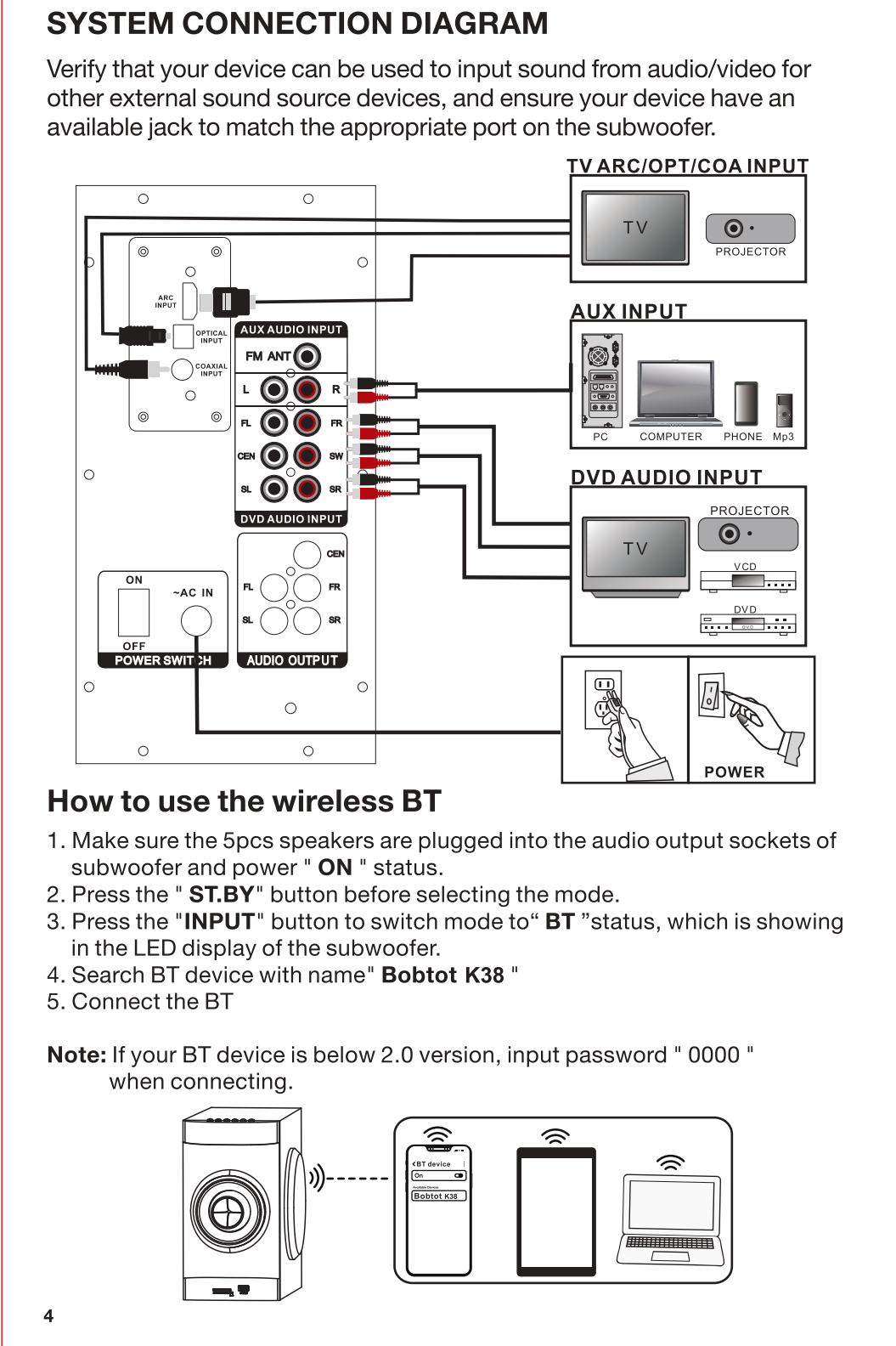
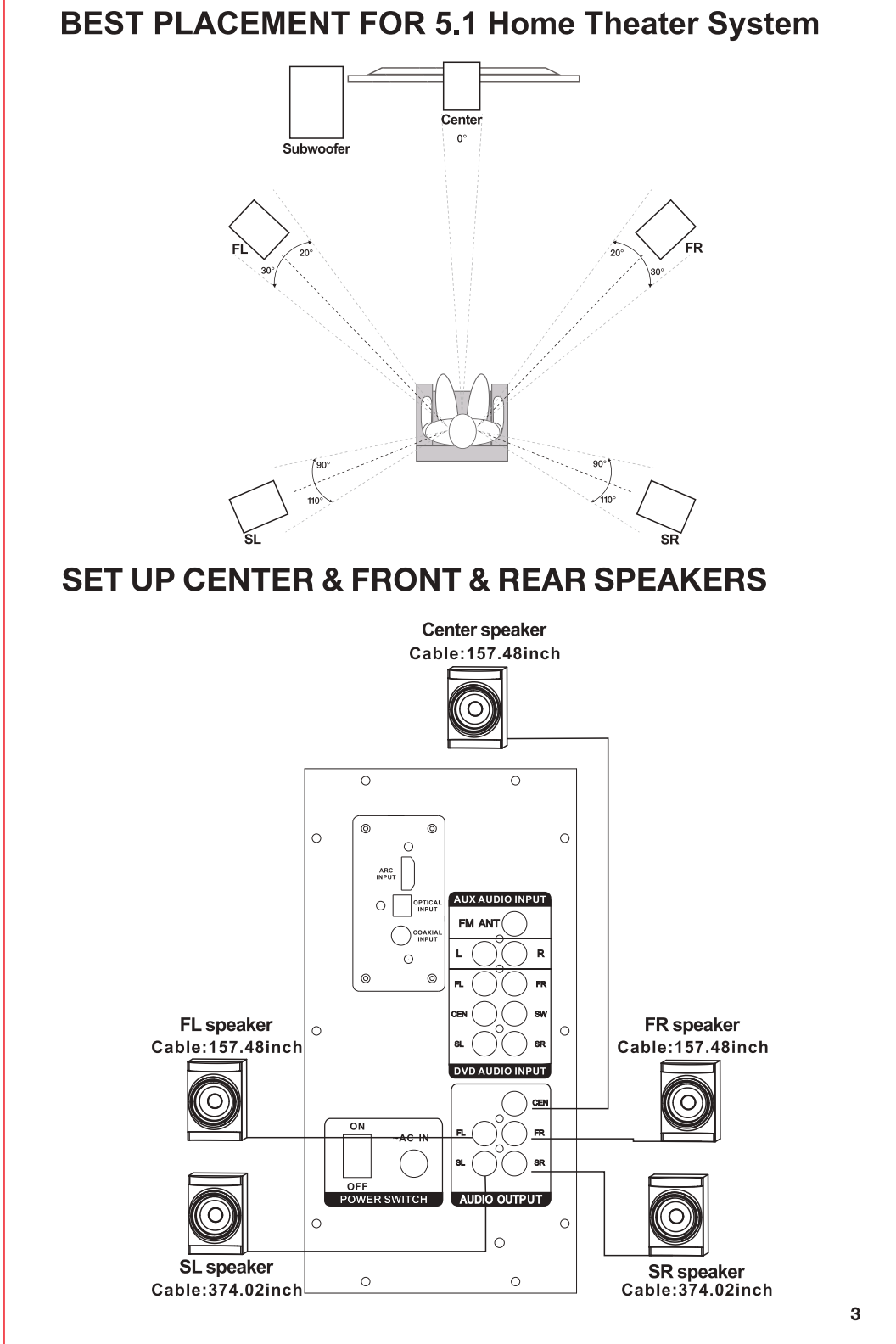

Press to previous channel when in FM mode.

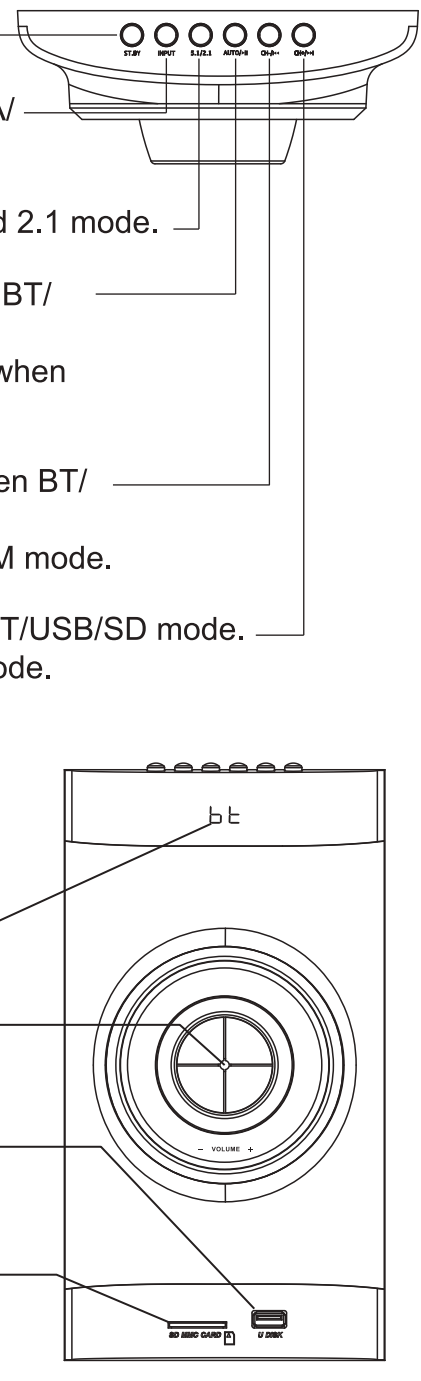
**CH/▶/|:** Press to next song when BT/USB/SD mode.

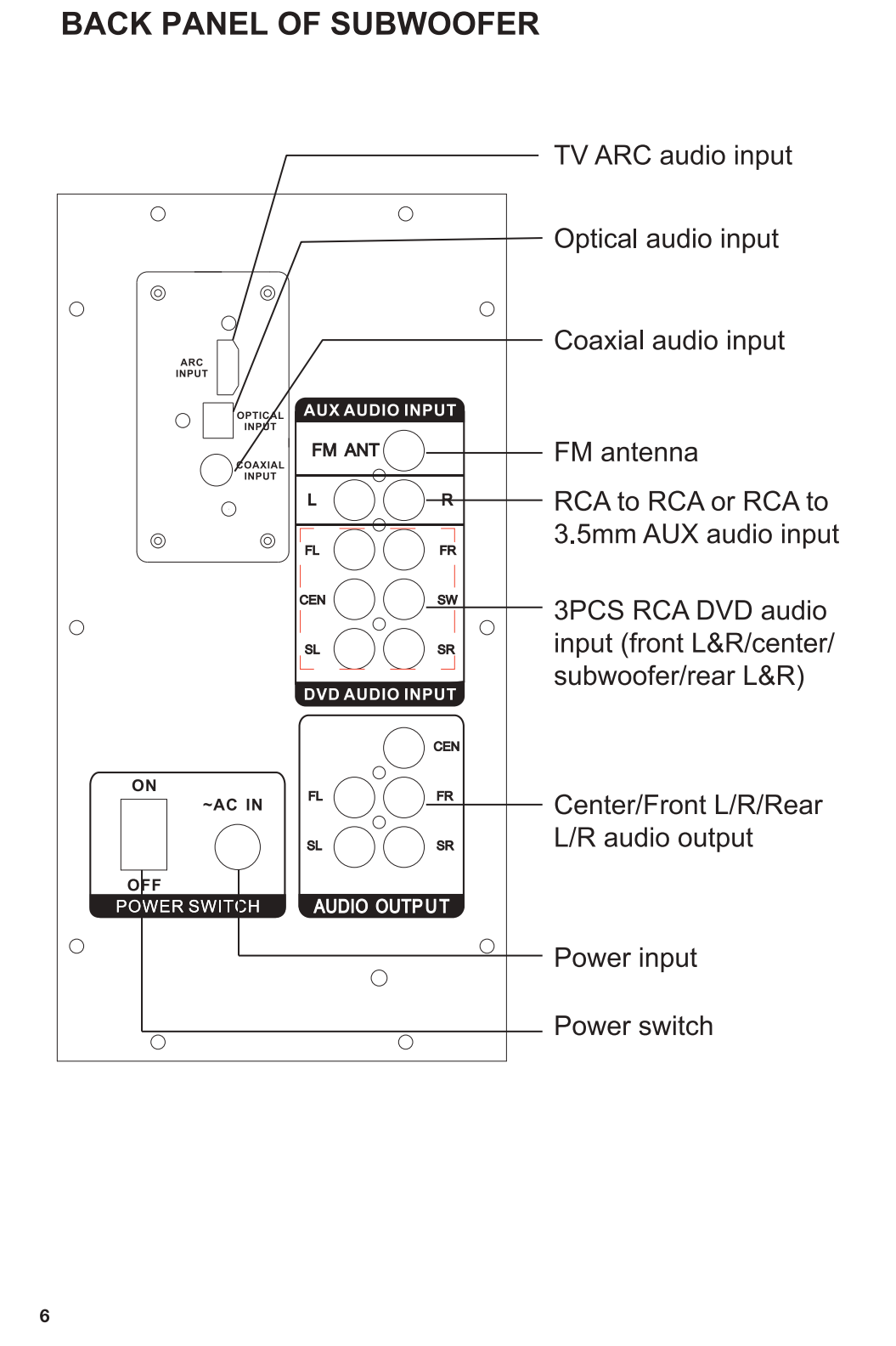

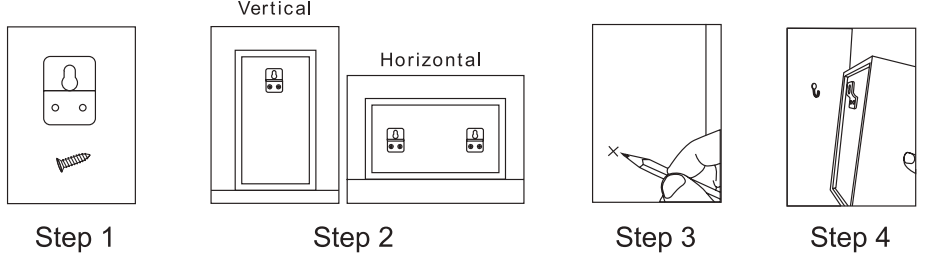

**REMOTE CONTROL FUNCTIONS**

: Power/Standby

**MUTE:** Press "MUTE" to mute all output.

**BT:** Press "BT" to use BT input mode. The LED Display will blink while searching for a BT device, pair with "Bobtot K38" in your mobile device BT menu.

**ARC/OPT/COA/DVD/AUX/USB/SD/FM:** Press the corresponding mode on the remote control to enter directly.

**5.1/2.1:** Press "5.1/2.1" to change from 2.1 to 5.1 surround sound.

**SLEEP +/-:** Set the sleep time.

**SAVE:** Press "SAVE" to save FM channels for memory.

**TUNE +/-:** Tuning the FM channels

**◀/▶:** In BT/USB/SD mode, press to play the previous song.

**CH:** In FM mode, press to go to the previous radio station channel.

**▶/▶:** Short Press to play/pause in BT/USB/SD mode.

**AUTO:** Long press to search for the FM channels automatically/ stop to search for the FM channels in FM mode

**▶/▶:** In BT/USB/SD mode, press to play the previous song.

**CH+:** In FM mode, press to go to the next radio station channel.

**FRONT:** Press "FRONT" to select the front speakers, the output level can be adjusted by using the "VOL +/-" buttons.

**CENT:** Press "CENT" to select the center speakers, the output level can be adjusted by using the "VOL +/-" buttons.

**REAR:** Press "REAR" to select the rear satellite speakers, the output level can be adjusted by using the "VOL +/-" buttons.

**SUBWOOFER:** Press "SUB" to select the subwoofer, the output level can be adjusted by using the "VOL +/-" buttons.

**VOL +/-:** Adjust the main volume.

**EQ +/-:** In BT/USB/SD mode, they will allow you to navigate the 5 preset EQ curves.

**DISP +/-:** They will to adjust the LED display brightness showing in the front of subwoofer.

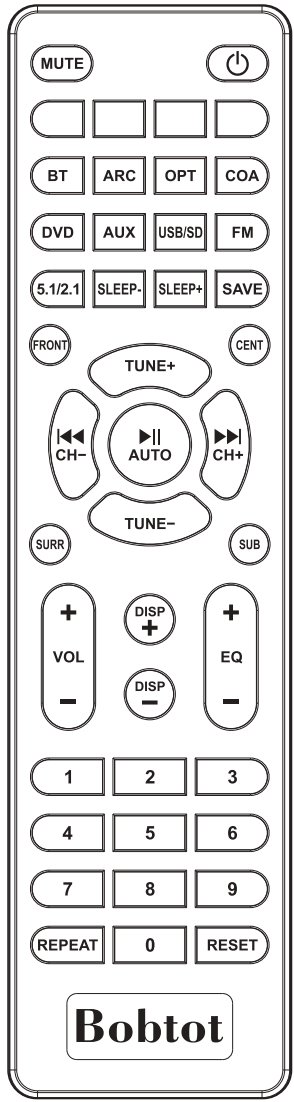
**0-9 NUMBER:** In USB/SD mode, press the number buttons to select the desired track. In FM mode, press the number buttons to select the desired radio station.

**REPEAT:** Press to single loop (music)/repeat all songs/random playback in BT/USB/SD mode.

**RESET:** Press to default state.

**NOTE:**

1. Turn on the unit, please press the "Power" button before selecting the input mode.
2. If the remote control does not work, please replace the batteries and try again.

**Connect your TV**

1. Plug the **TV ARC / Optical / Coaxial cable** into the audio input on the back of the subwoofer, the other port plugs into the socket of your TV.
2. Make sure the 5 satellite speakers have been plugged into the audio output of the subwoofer and are in the "Power On" status.
3. Press the "ST. BY" button on the subwoofer or press "ON" on the remote to start this system.
4. Press the "INPUT" button on the subwoofer to switch mode "ARC/OPT/COA", which is showing in the LED display of the subwoofer, or press the "ARC/OPT/COA" button on the remote.
5. TV Setting- Sound output - select your mode to "TV ARC / Optical / Coaxial"
6. TV Setting- Expert Setting - Digital Output Audio Format Setting to "PCM".

**Note:**

- 1.For optical connections, please make sure the protective caps at the ends of the optical cable are removed before plugging it in.
- 2.The coaxial cable is not included.

**Other System Connection**

1. For 5.1 surround sound, insert audio cables from your device into the corresponding DVD speaker sockets at the back of subwoofer. (FL/FR, CEN/SW,SL/SR input )
2. For dimensional sound, you can insert the audio cable connected to the AUX port of your device into the back of subwoofer, or insert a USB flash drive into the USB socket at the front of the subwoofer, or insert an SD/MMC card into SD input at the front of subwoofer.
3. For clear, stronger FM signal, insert white antenna cord into FM Antenna socket at the back of subwoofer. Press "FM" on the remote control to enter FM mode, and then press "AUTO/▶|◀" to search the stations automatically and will save the FM station automatically.
4. In FM mode, semi - automatic station - searching, press "TUNE +/-" to select a station you like.
