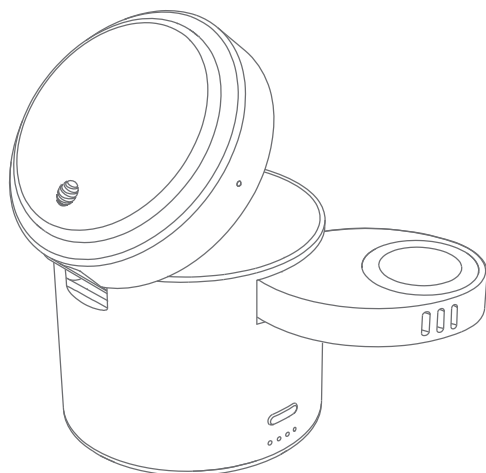

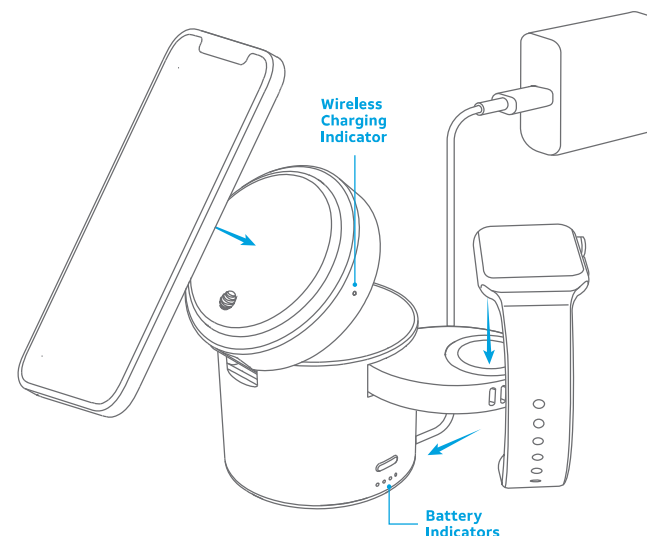
## Using your 3-in-1 Power Drum Wireless Charger

- 1 Power up the unit by using the provided USB-C cable and wall charger. Connect one end of the USB-C plug to the power drum and the other end of the USB-C plug to the wall charger.
- 2 Place your phone on the magnetic charger, and charging will automatically begin. If not, push the ON/OFF button.
- 3 To charge your Apple Watch, slide out the holder and place the watch properly on the charger. Charging will automatically begin. If not, push the ON/OFF button.
- 4 To charge using the USB-C output, use the correct cable (not included). Connect one end using the USB-C to the power drum and the other end to your device. Push the power button on the power drum, and your device will begin charging automatically.

**\*This product has a built-in 5000mAh battery, which can charge the mobile phone and Apple Watch without connecting the power supply.**

## Charging Indicator Light Status

- Red flashing light: ERROR, please re-position your device
- Green light: CHARGING, lights up green, flashes 3 times and goes off (device will remain charging)



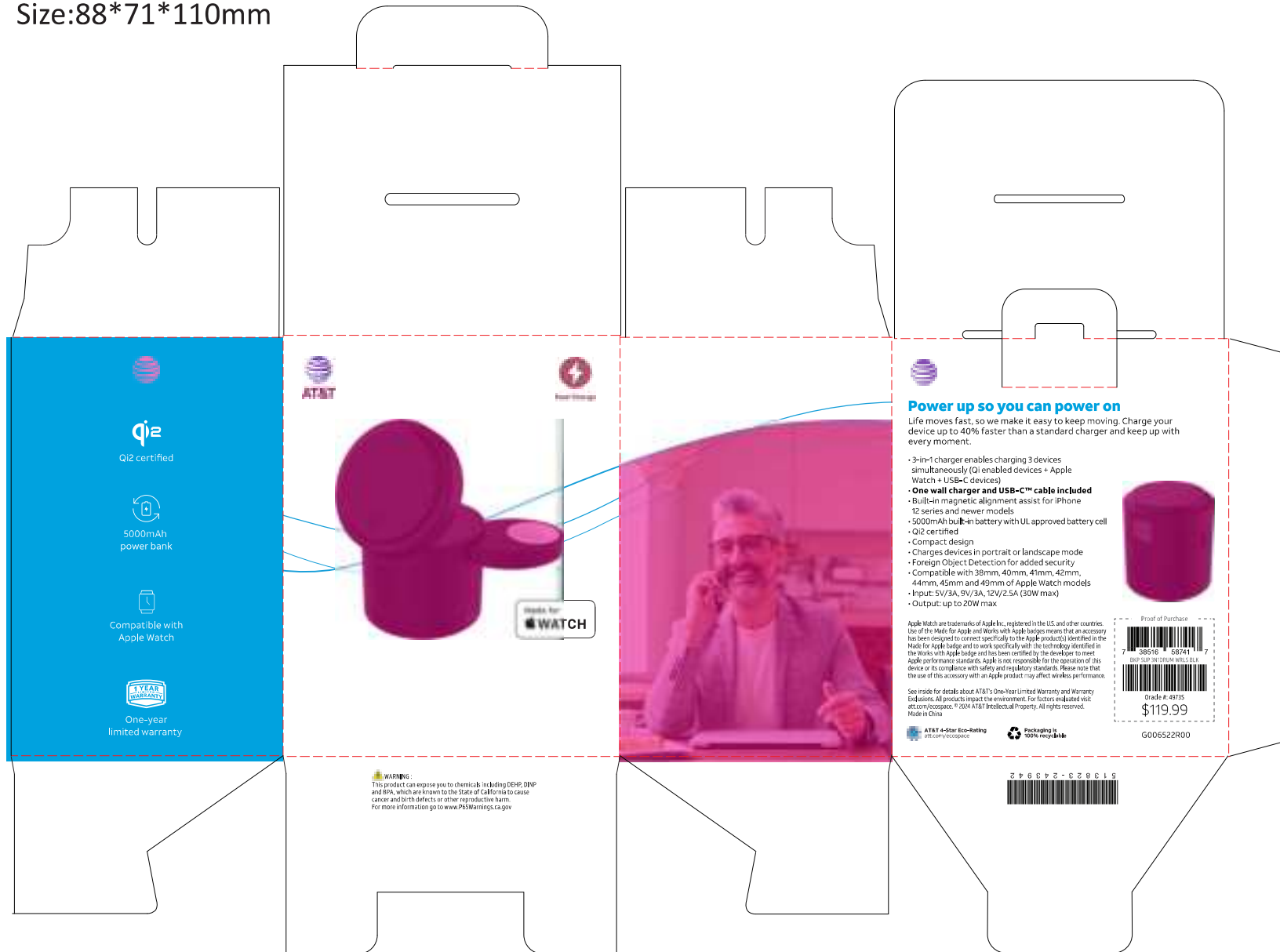

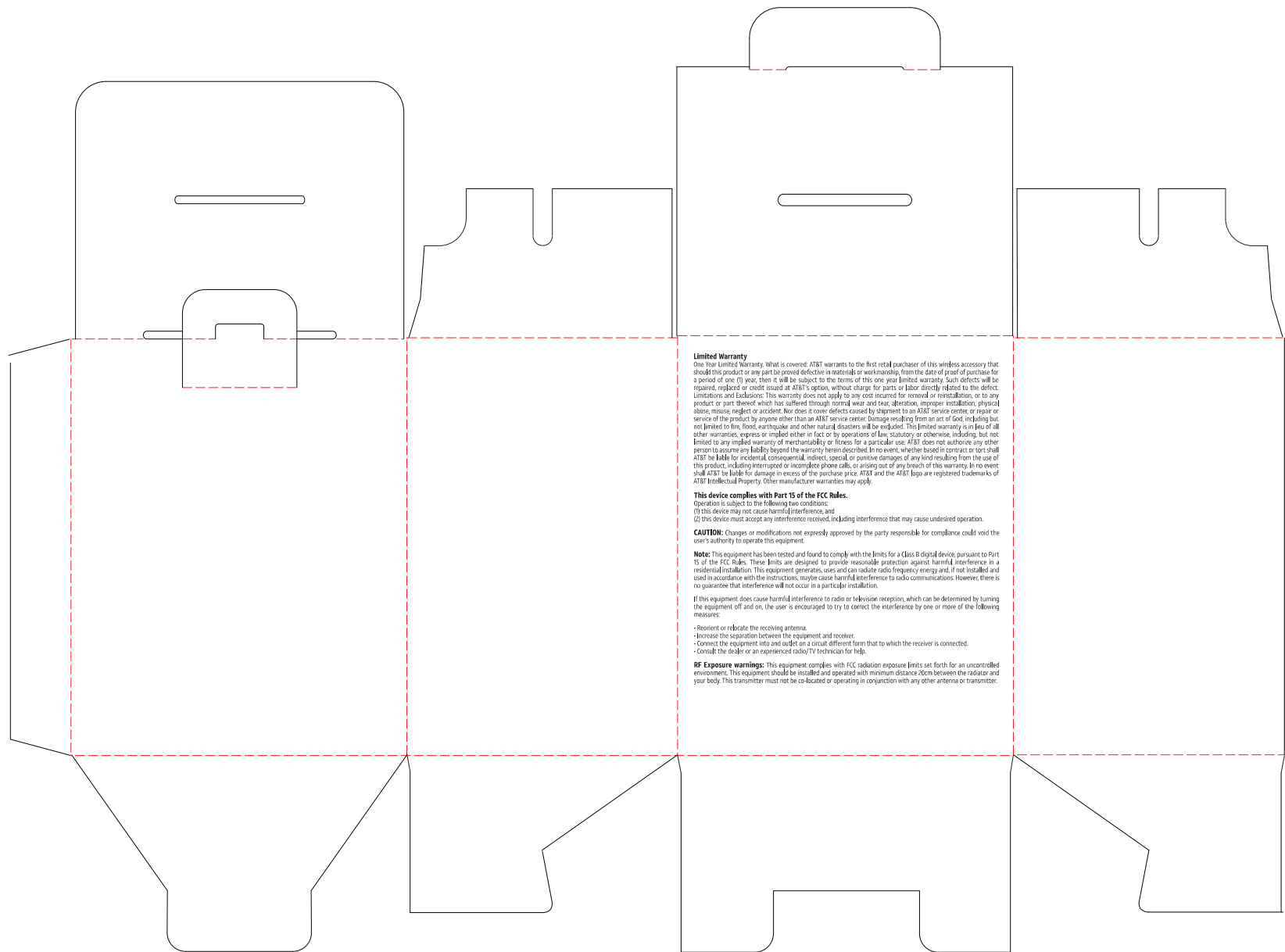
- ○ ○ ○ 4 lights = full battery
