Coding your new transmitter to your product (Models 20630)

- 1. Power down the unit by pulling out the 15 amp blue fuse for a few seconds, then replace it. You will hear a quick confirmation chirp. You now need to program the unit to recognize all of the transmitters you will be using.
- 2. Press and hold the middle button on the first transmitter until you hear a chirp from the siren. To teach multiple transmitters (up to 4), repeat this process within five seconds with each additional transmitter. Only one button needs to be pushed per transmitter.
