KEY FUNCTION

WIRELESS PAIRING

the initial use.

 Place the mobile phone or media player device next to it. Press & hold the power button for 3 seconds to enter the pairing mode. it will be automatically turn off after disconnect bluetooth about 10 min.
- Activate the wireless feature on media player device and search for "My speaker F013" from the list to pair with. Enter "0000" if the media device prompts for a password.
- 3. If pairing fails, please refer to the user manual of media player device for wireless setup. Remove all the excessive unused models from the list of paired devices and start over from step 1 again.


RECHARGING THE DEVICE

TROUBLE SHOOTING

Symptoms	Causes	Solutions
F013 Can't be powered on	Low battery level	Recharge the battery
Not able to pair with the speaker	F013 is already on or not to the pairing mode.	Refer to "Wireless pairing section" in the previous page.
Volume too low	Battery is not charged up or volume is not set the maximun on both F013 & media player.	1.Increase the volume via pressing & holding the volume up button. 2.Increase the volume on the media players.
FM Radio Signals	To receive optimal FM radio signal,relocate F013 to open environment, remove from a closed loop area, or move it away from other electronic devices to reduce the interferences. If applicable, plug with the charging cable as an external antenna to possibly increase the signal strength.
