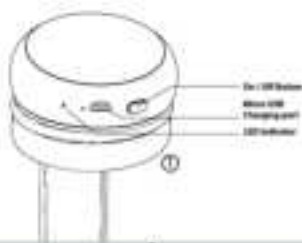

How to use 4.1.General Functions <table><tr><th>Desired Result</th><th>Required Action</th></tr><tr><td>Turn on & Enter the pairing mode</td><td>Press and hold the On / Off Button for 2 seconds. After turning on, the LED indicator flashes red/blue.</td></tr><tr><td>Pairing</td><td>Use a mobile phone with Bluetooth function or other Bluetooth devices to perform successful pairing action. After pairing, the LED indicator slowly blinks with blue.</td></tr><tr><td>Turn off</td><td>Press and hold the On / Off Button for 2 seconds.</td></tr><tr><td>Charging</td><td>Plug the Micro USB plug to the Micro USB port. When charging, the LED indicator turns red. 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4.2. Pairing to Mobile phone or other device To use your Bluetooth headphones, you must first pair your headphones with a mobile phone or other Bluetooth devices. Once your Bluetooth headphones is paired to a specific mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range. Pairing to a phone and Entertainment: • Turn on your phone and ensure the Bluetooth function is activated. • Turn on the headphones, enter the pairing mode. • Search your Bluetooth devices on your phone by following the phone's instructions. Refer to your phone's user manual for more information. • After a few seconds the phone will list the "BT CAT HP" as a discover device. Select it and follow your phone's instructions to select this pairing. • Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/OK.	4.3. Charging your headphones ⚠ For your safety, please always use an appropriate 5V input charger/Adapter to charge the product. DO NOT USE Quick Charging USB Adapter to charge the product, as it might damage the product. Use the Micro USB Charging cable accessory provided with this headphones. Connect the Micro USB plug to the Micro USB charging port on the headphones positioned at ① in headphones diagram on page 2. Connect the USB plug to a USB port on a computer or wall adapter to activate charging. **Make sure to keep the headphones charging for a minimum of 2 hours before initial use.  Warning: • You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer. • You must charge the Bluetooth headphones if it has not been used for more than 6 months.	5.
