Hi Tom,

I think maybe I need to clarify a little bit about the operation of this product.

It includes two GSM modules, basically means two GSM phones being combined together.

They can register on different networks at the same time.

It is not possible to make phone calls on both two modules at the same time, but when the user is in a phone call with one of the modules, and if there is a call coming from the other one, the user can choose to accept the second call, which will end the current call at the same time.

We think the worst situation should be that a call was set up with one module, and on the other module there was an incoming call but not accepted. Actually for CE we did test in this way.
