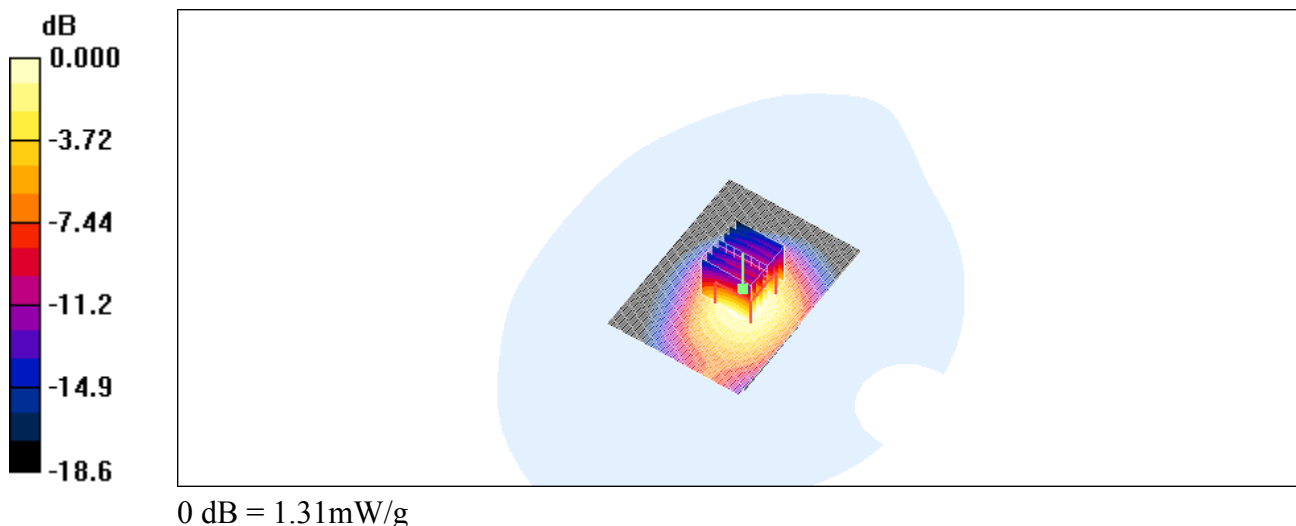

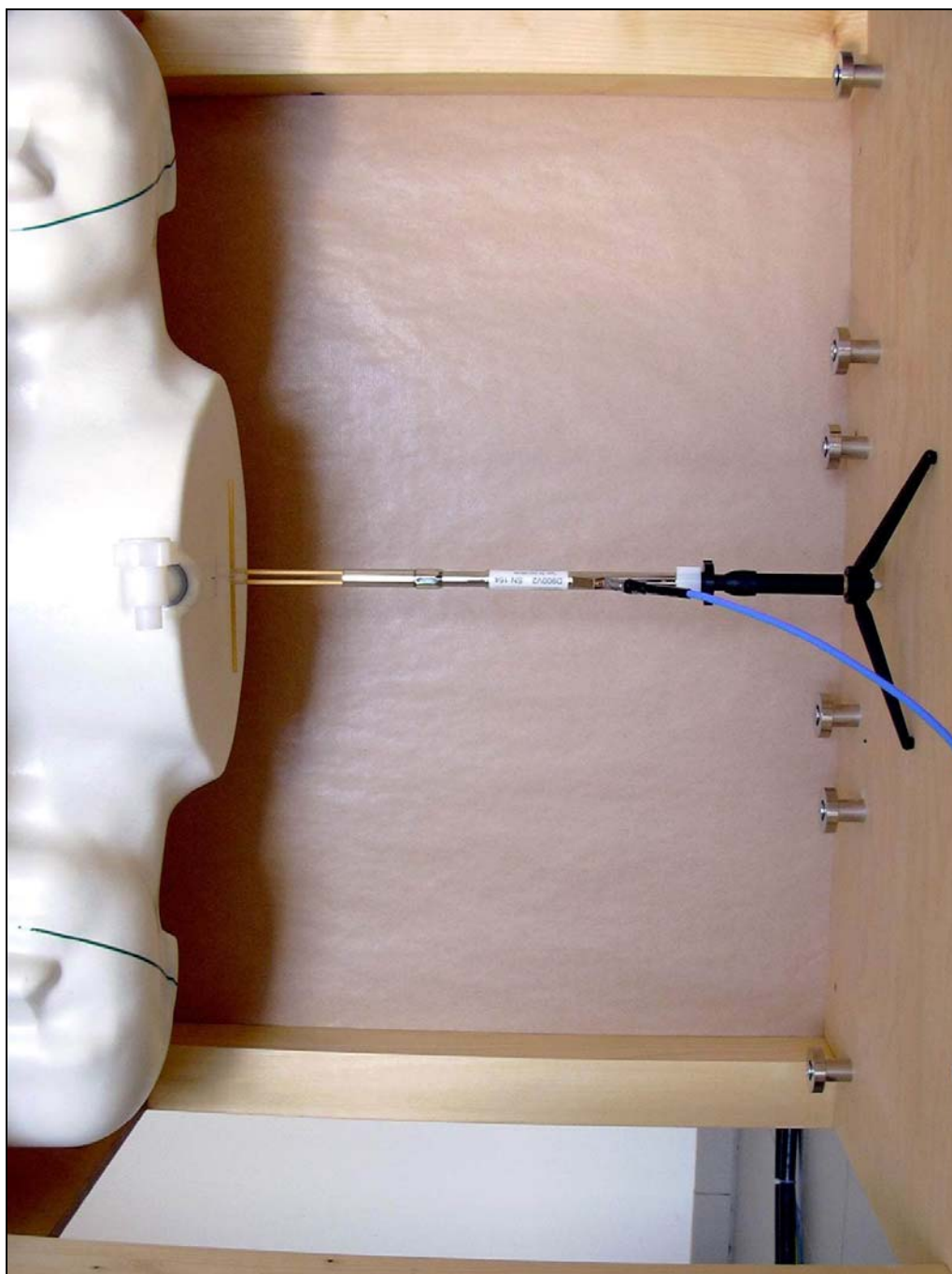




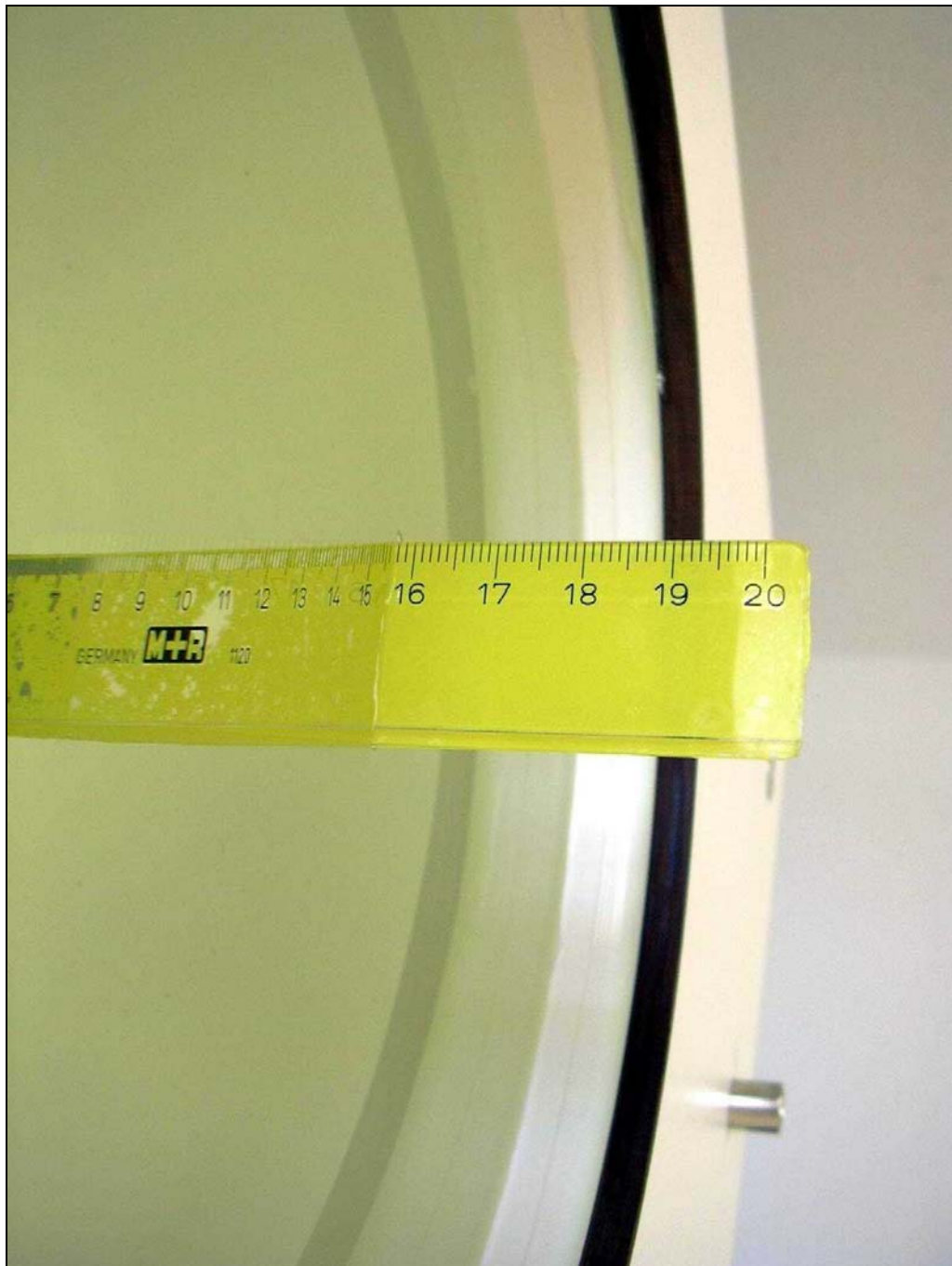
Valid 1900
