The equipment, Qualcomm model QSec-2700, is for mobile station cellular and PCS system use. The QSec-2700 is in full compliance with all parts of EIA/TIA/IS-98-B Mobile Station-Land Station Compatibility Specification, issue July 1998, and also in full compliance with all parts of ANSI J-STD-018, Recommended Minimum Performance Requirements for 1.8 to 2 GHz Code Division Multiple Access (CDMA) Personal Stations, issue July 1996.

The Class 2 Permissive Change is a result of two new leather holster accessories that have different construction than the original belt clip. Both holsters have identical clip designs and dimensions, and therefore only one holster, QUALCOMM part number 700-47205-0001, was tested as representative of both models. The second holster, QUALCOMM part number 700-47205-002, has an additional leather flap to cover the front of the phone. The SAR test data in Appendix A of the QSec-2700 SAR report was performed for this Class 2 Permissive Change request.
