Important Safety Instructions

It is very important that you avoid direct exposure to the laser beam at all times. Please do not attempt to defeat or bypass the safety switches.

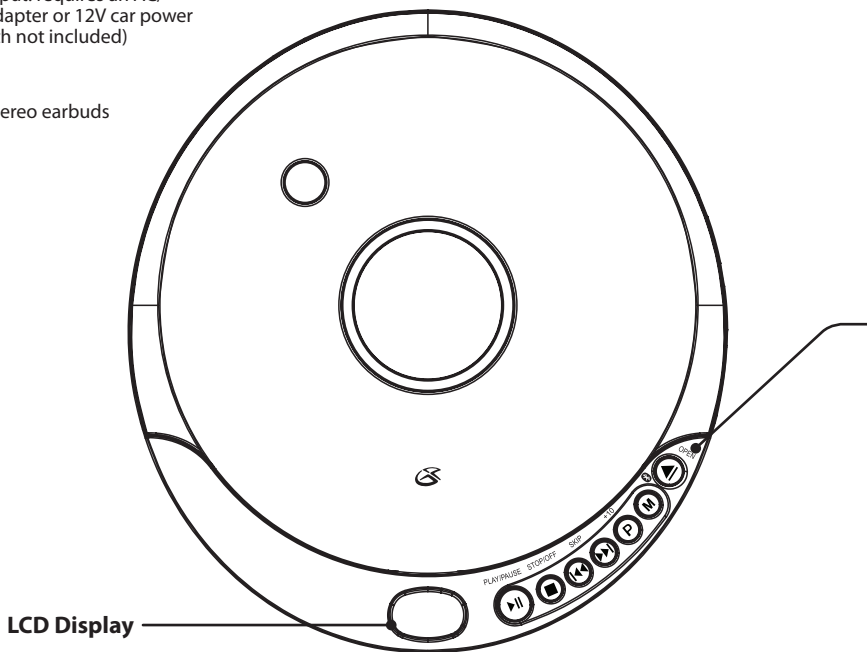
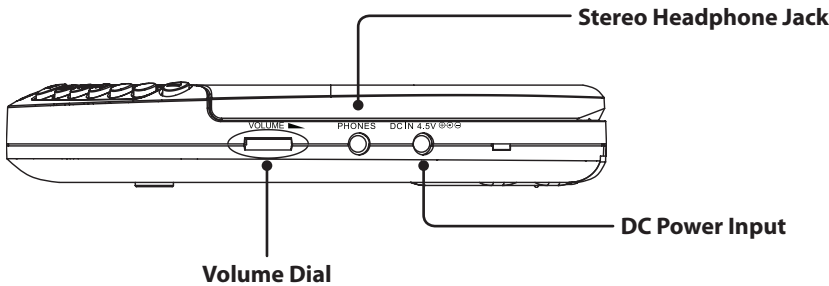
Functions & Controls

Features:

- Bluetooth wireless transmitter
- CD player: CD, CD-R/RW, MP3 CD
- 40 sec. anti-skip protection for CDs
- 100 sec. anti-skip protection for MP3 CDs
- Analog volume control
- LCD display
- Low battery indicator
- Stereo headphone jack
- DC battery power: requires 2 AA size batteries (not included)

Play/Pause

Press to play or pause a loaded CD.

Stop/OFF

Press to stop a CD during play.

In stop mode, press to power OFF the CD player.

Skip/Search

Press to skip between tracks on a loaded CD. Press and hold to search an individual track on a loaded CD.

P/+10

Press to program a CD to play tracks in a specified order.

Press during play to skip 10 tracks (MP3 CD ONLY).

M (Mode)

Press and hold to switch to Bluetooth Transmitter Mode.

Press to select repeat mode:

REP 1 - repeat a single track

ALL - repeat an entire CD

DIR - repeat a directory on an MP3 CD

RND - play tracks in a random order

INTRO - play the CD in Intro mode

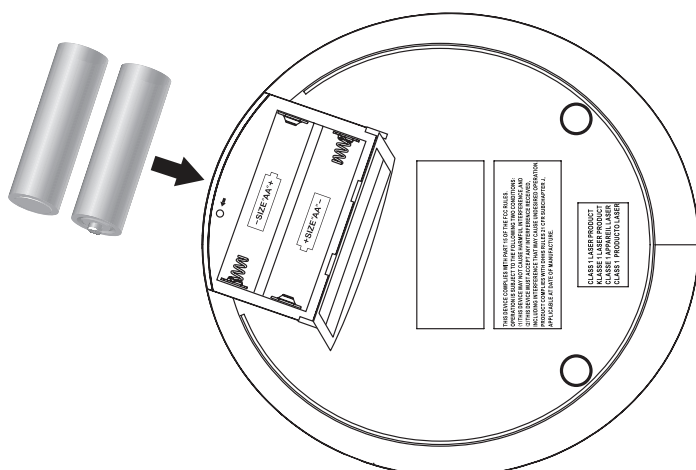
Open

Press to open the CD door.

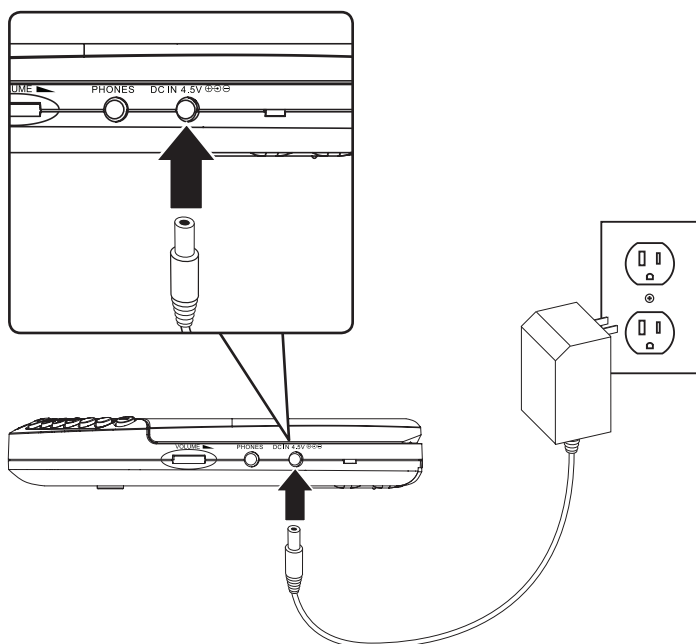
Power

Requires 2 AA batteries (not included).

Note: Please remove batteries if using the USB cable for power.



Using an AC/DC power adapter (not included), connect the DC power input on the unit to a standard power outlet.



CD

Loading a CD

1. Press the **OPEN** button to open the CD door.
2. Load a CD into the player, label side up.
3. Close the CD door.

Playing a CD

1. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to begin playing the loaded CD.

Programming a CD

1. Press the **STOP** button to stop the CD during play.
2. Press the **P** button, "P-01" will begin to blink on the display.
3. Press the **SKIP/SEARCH** buttons to select the track you wish to program.
4. Press the **P** button to save the selected track to the program.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to program up to 20 tracks to play in the order they are programmed.
6. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to begin playing the programmed tracks.

Bluetooth Transmitter Mode

Pairing to a Bluetooth Speaker

The CD player can act as a Bluetooth transmitter to a Bluetooth speaker. Follow the below steps to connect to a Bluetooth speaker and play music from a loaded CD.

When using Bluetooth, there is no output from the headphone jack.

When the CD player is stopped for approximately 30 seconds, the power will be automatically turn off. The user will need to repeat below connection steps to play in Bluetooth Mode again.

1. Press and hold the **Mode** button to switch to **Bluetooth Pairing Mode**.
2. When the CD player is in Bluetooth Mode, "BT" will be seen flashing on the LCD display. The pairing process could take up to 30 seconds. For best results, stay within 3 ft. of the Bluetooth speaker you are pairing to.
3. When the Bluetooth connection is made, the "BT" icon on the LCD display will stop flashing and turn solid. Your Bluetooth speaker should indicate when the connection has been made as well. *Note: The unit will connect to the closest Bluetooth speaker that is near it.*
4. Begin playing music on the CD player to hear it on the connected Bluetooth speaker. If you are connected to a Bluetooth speaker with a play/pause button and do not hear audio, try pressing the play/pause button.
5. When you are finished listening, press the **Stop** button to stop the player.
6. Press and hold the **Mode** button to turn off Bluetooth transmitter mode.
