

Function is introduced:



- 1, Manual mode
- 2. The direction key
- 3. Point A return
- 4. Slow down
- 5. Automatic mode
- 6. B to return
- 7. To speed up
- 8. Remote receiver head

Connection is introduced:

- 1. Connect the receiver head to the USB port at the back of the visual box
- 2. Install the remote control

Used to introduce:

Use the remote control to press manual mode first, and then you can control the machine. If you do not want to control the automatic mode, or wait for 60S will automatically switch
