

Bluetooth Pairing

- Repairing: turn off the Bluetooth function of the connected smart devices, at this time, the Bluetooth headset and the last matching device got disconnected, LED light flashed between red and blue, and enter the Bluetooth pairing mode, then turn on the Bluetooth function of the smart devices, search the device named "E63" to get connected, after pairing successfully, the voice prompts "connected", the blue LED is on and flash slowly.

- Subsequent pairing: 3 seconds after powering on, the headphone will automatically search and connect the smart device which paired last time.

Other Functions

- Warning voice of maximum volume: "Dudu"
- Power saving mode: the headphone will automatically turn off after 5 minutes of no connection
- TYPE-C charging port, user friendly.

LED Indicator

 Charging
 red LED is on when charging, and blue LED is on after full charged

 Pairing
 Blue and red LED flashes alternately
