- Check whether the strength's appropriate to prevent excessive pressure.
 Please set it accoming to the instructions in this member.
- When using a separate cellar to the degleash, it is not allowed to overlap if on the training collar to avoid excessive pressure at the contact point of the collars.
- Clean the dog's neck and coller contact points with a wet cloth everyweek.
- Check the neck of the dog in contact with the collar daily for signs of resh or bedecree.
- If resh or bedsore is found, please stop using the coller unit, the skin heals.
- If the rash or bedsore persists for more than 48 hours, please take your dog to the vet.





5. Product setting steps

"In accordance with the following product steps before using the dog training collar:

5.1. Controller and receiver charging



When the charging is complated, the green light will be on.

5.2. Installation of contact points and silicone caps

- Select the correct contact point and length of silicone cap according to your dog's hair type.
- For dogs with thick hair, please use 2 long contact points and silicone caps.
- For dogs with short heir please use 2 short contact points and silicone caps.
- Insert the contact point into the port of the collar, use the test lamp to rotate clockwise and tighten it SIAI.
- Install the allicone cap on the contact point to make it softer it can be more comfortable to the dog's skin (3BL).








5.3. Adjustable collar

- 1. Under the strap from the slide buckle KAL
- 2. Adjust the slide buckle according to the size of the dog [4B].
- 3. Pass the strap through the slide buckle I4Cl.
- Throad the secess strap through the buckle (4D).



5.4 Test

1. Turning on the receiver cellar

Innormal mode, the green LED light will flash every 4 seconds, indicating that the receiver sollar instarted on and ready to receive the signal from the remote control device. Note: The blue LED flashing means to use the electric shock, the green LED flashing means to use the beginning, and the red LED Flashing means the battery is low.)

2. Turning off the receiver collar

Press receiver collar button for 3 seconds until the red LED light appear.

Note: in order to prolong the battery life please turn off the receiver collarwhen out in use.

3. Runction test

"We suggest you to experience the feeling at different levels for yourself, starting from the lowest level, and then increasing the level until you test uncomfortable.

Put she finger on the two contact points of the training collar. Put your remote control about 2 feet away from the training collar, and presents wheeting/abook butten continuously for 1 to 2 seconds, you will feet the continuous wheeting the continuous.

First press the vincetica/heap/shock button next to the controller, and then adjust the strength through the switch local of the controller. From level 1, press the shock button, increase the level until you feel uncomfortable.



First press the vioration/beep/shock button read to the controller to adjust the adjust the etrength through the switch knob of the controller to adjust the strength for other don/beep/shock. The other libration level can be adjusted from 1 us 9, and the static shock level can be adjusted from 1 to 99. Please adjust it according to your dog's reaction. It is not recommended to hold down the wibration button for too long to senid any physiological or psychological impact on your dog.

5.5. How to use the test light

1. Shock function test

- Turn on the receiver collar.
- Attach the contactor of the test light to the contact point for conductive silicone).
- Press the shock button, and the test light will light up, it will light up according to the increase of shock degree.

5.6. Pairing

*NOTE:

You can skip this step because this setting has been pained by the factory settings.

- 1. Please ensure that the receiver is turned off.
- 2. Hold down the switch for 5 seconds until the green light flashes quickly.



 Controller pairing: Just press any button on the front of the controller to pair the receiver (Like beep or vibration or shock button).



4. Pairing succeeded: the receiver will beep and the green light will flash slowly.



5.7. Installing the receiver collar



NOTE

The contact point must directly contact the skin of the dog's neck, check the tightness of the collar, and insert two fingers tightly between the collar and neck.

5.8. Turning on the remote control and receiver



When the collar is not used, please turn off the controller and receiver to increase the battery life. [Press the button for 3 seconds to turn off the receiver]




5.10. Three training mode instructions

1. Beep instruction



Sive an instruction to the receiver to been at a unadjustable volume

2. Vibration instruction



Elick + or - to control the vibration level, the lowest level is L and the highest level is H

Continuously intrate when present for a long time, and autimetically stop intrating after 30 seconds (intration 15 times), and the time interval for continuous vibration is 25.

3. Static stimulation instruction



5.11. Multiple receiver systems

INDTE: If you only use one receiver; please skip this step. This setting only applies to multiple receivers with one remote control.]

Step 1: Pairing the 2nd, 3rd or 4th receiver.

INOTE: You should buy an extra receiver collar.

Pair the remote with the receiver:

- 1. Make sure the receiver is turned all.
- 2. Press and hold the receiver switch for 5 seconds until the green light flashes quickly.
- Switch to the channel you want to use, then press any button to pair the receiver.
- 4. Pairing successful. The receiver will beep

Step 2: Receiver Switching Contrain 4 dags at the same time

You can switch between different channels for training by pressing the channel button. Each channel fear a memory function, which will leep the content you set last time.



Training Tips

- 1. Reventing your dog with booklinests will usually help to achieve the best training result.
- 2 Do not use the device on dogs aged below 6-months, old, pregrant, easily highlaned, aggressive, in heat, and in inferior health conditions.
- 3: Use verbal commands first, and supplement with a corrective stimulus only as peeded. Be consistent with your verbal commands, and use the same words every time. Work with your perone between stations and confusion and trustration.
- Use as little stimulus as possible and only reinfonce winted commands when necessary.
 Do not overcorrect your dog.
- 5. For example, use the beep sound as a warring by pressing the beep botton. The dog will become conditioned to the beep preceding the corrective standard and will soon learn to recognize the beep as a warring along with your winted command.

5.12. Matters needing attention in pet training

1. Select contact points and conductive silicone.

For the best effect, please choose the right contact point according to your dog's cost.

For dogs with thick hair, please use 2 long contact points and sill cone caps.

For dags with short hair, please use 2 after t contact points and ellisons cape.

2. Accessories suitable for training

Please wear the collar correctly so that the contact point is close to the dog's skin.

After the collar is wern correctly you should be able to put workingers between the masker collar and the dog's need.

Too loose: the receiver collar will move around your dog's neck, and the contact point may hurt your dog's skin.

Too tight it may cause breathing difficulties to your dog.

Protautions-
