Getting Started

- USB charging cradle

To save the battery, the Activity
Tracker is set into hibernation mode
when out the factory. Before first use,
please long press screen for 10 seconds
to activate the device. The progress bar
will change from empty to full to
indicate full activation as below:





Install the FITRAX ActiveLife APP on your smartphone/tab et/PC





The bluetooth is always on without mark





Run APP to search the device then connect







Set personal information









 Touch the screen once within 8 seconds to show the screens as below



Mode Change



Long press the screen for 2 seconds till the sleep mark shows, then short touch the screen to enter the sleep mode, if not touched within 2 seconds, the tracker will stay at activity mode.



3. Long press the screen for 2 seconds till the people mark shows, then short touch the screen to enter the activity mode, if not touched within 2 seconds, the tracker will stay at sleep mode.




How to Wear the Activity Tracker

Battery Charge

- The empty battery mark will display when the battery is low or runs out.
- The whole charging process will normally take 1 or 2 hours.
- A fully charged tracker should last for apporximately 5-7 days.

Note: Please charge the battery at least once a month to prolong battery life even when not using the activity tracker for a long time.
