






HOW TO POWER ON AND PAIR THE EARPHONES

- When the earphones are removed from the charging case, they will automatically turn on and pair to each other automatically.
- 2. Bluetooth pairing name: k023W
- When using the earphones later, it will automatically connect to the phone.
- Earphones will automatically turn off if there is not connected to phone after 5 minutes.
