Changing Audio Profiles

Status Icons

Changing the Audio Profiles allows you to change the device volume levels. This menu will be found in

There are preset Audio Profiles: 1. General - These are the default audio levels recommend 2. Silent - These settings mute all audio notification 3. Meeting - These settings put all audio to vibration

4. Indoor - These settings make all audio levels low

5. Outdoor - These settings make all audio to max

You can edit any of these settings by selecting Option (==-)

In these settings you will be able to change the ringtones, adjust volume levels, select ring type, and additional audio settings

SOS Settings

The SOS functionality on the device allows you to set up five (5) emergency numbers that will receive a custom text message and will automatically call the numbers in the order they are set.

Disclaimer: No numbers are preset to the device, user must set their own numbers. Device must have an active service running for this function to work properly.
