

RF Exposure evaluation

According to 447498 D04 Interim General RF Exposure Guidance v01

$$P_{\rm th} \, ({\rm mW}) = ERP_{\rm 20\,cm} \, ({\rm mW}) = \begin{cases} 2040 f & 0.3 \, {\rm GHz} \le f < 1.5 \, {\rm GHz} \\ \\ 3060 & 1.5 \, {\rm GHz} \le f \le 6 \, {\rm GHz} \end{cases} \tag{B.1}$$

$$P_{\text{th}} \text{ (mW)} = \begin{cases} ERP_{20 \text{ cm}} (d/20 \text{ cm})^{x} & d \le 20 \text{ cm} \\ ERP_{20 \text{ cm}} & 20 \text{ cm} < d \le 40 \text{ cm} \end{cases}$$

where

$$x = -\log_{10}\left(\frac{60}{ERP_{20\,\mathrm{cm}}\sqrt{f}}\right)$$

and f is in GHz, d is the separation distance (cm), and $ERP_{20\mathrm{cm}}$ is per Formula (B.1). The example values shown in Table B.2 are for illustration only.
