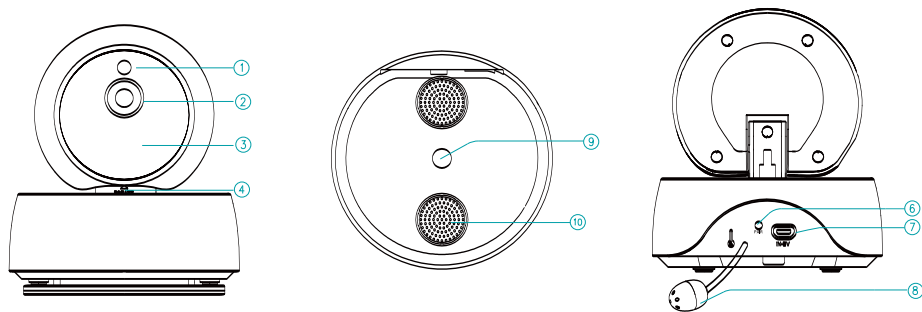
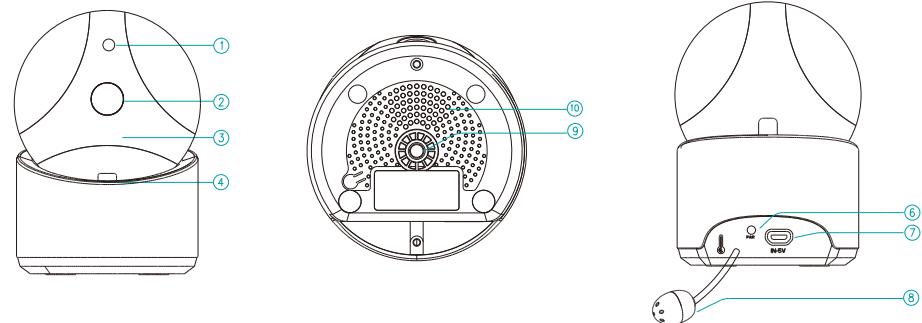
1. Keep the cord(s) away from children in case of strangulation (3 feet/ 1 meter away).
2. Put the product(s) in a dry place in case of short-circuit.
3. Use the AC adapter(s) provided by us ONLY. Using unauthorized charging cables and AC adapters may result in overheating even explosion.
4. Unplug the AC adapter(s) if you don't use it(them).
5. Check your baby's activities regularly as this product is not designed for supervision but for assisting your supervising.

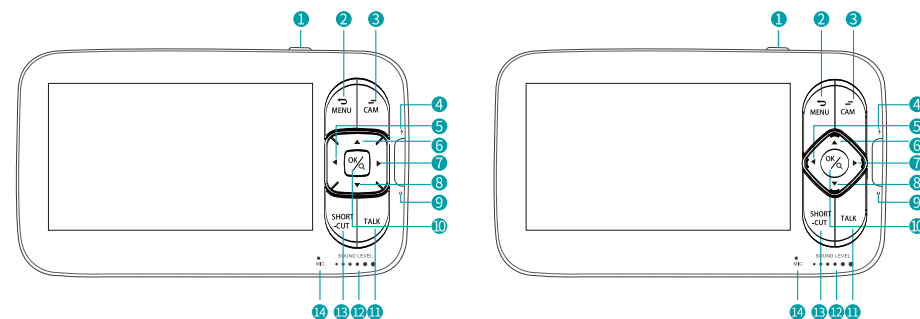
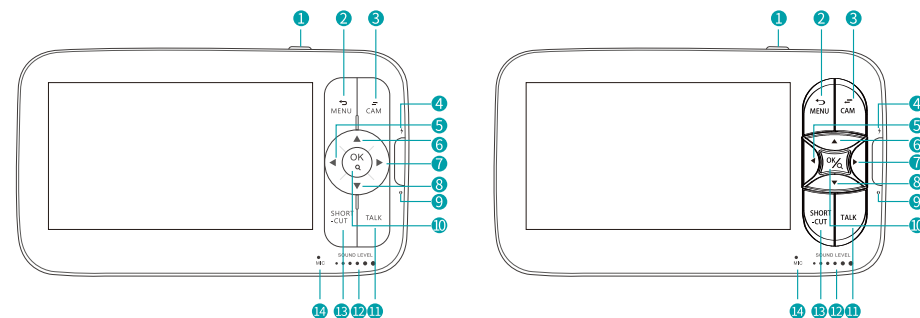

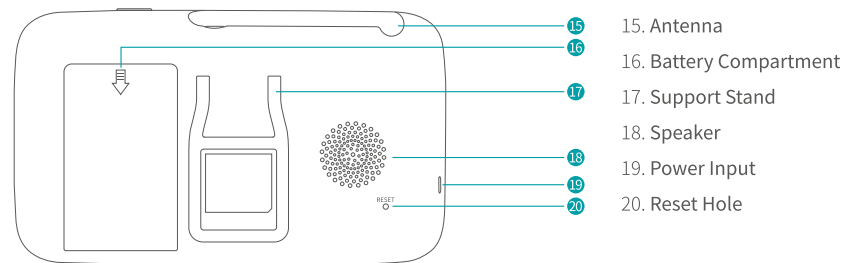

MONITOR



1. **Power/Sleep Button:** Long press to turn on/off the monitor; short press to turn on/off the screen.
2. **Menu/Back:** Press to enter menu page or press as a Back button.
3. **Camera Switch:** Switch cameras if connected with 2 or more cameras.
4. **Charging Indicator:** It gives off yellow light while the monitor is being charged.
5. **Left:** Press to pan the camera leftward or to change your selection leftward.
6. **Up:** Press to tilt the camera upward or to change your selection upward.
7. **Right:** Press to pan the camera rightward or to change your selection rightward.
8. **Down:** Press to tilt the camera downward or to change your selection downward.
9. **Power Indicator:** The green light turns on if connected to electricity.
10. **Zoom/OK:** Press to Zoom in/out or to confirm your selection.
11. **Talk:** Press to talk to your baby in the monitoring image.
12. **Sound Level LED:** Low/high level shows low/high sound detected by the camera.
13. **Volume/Brightness:** Press to adjust the monitor's volume or brightness in the monitoring image.
14. **Microphone**



Note:

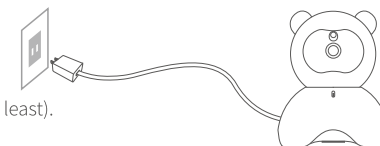
1. If you **RESET** with a pin, the monitor will be forced shutdown.
2. Do not open the battery compartment without official guidance.

GETTING STARTED

Step 1:

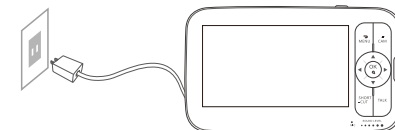
1. Connect the camera to the AC adapter.
2. Plug the AC adapter into a socket.

Note: Put the camera away from your baby (3ft/1m away at least).



Step 2:

1. Connect the monitor to the AC adapter.
2. Plug the AC adapter into a socket.
3. Long press the Power button to turn on the monitor then you can see the monitoring interface.



Note:

The monitor takes about 4 hours to be fully charged, and it lasts about 4-5 hours.

CAMERA SETTING

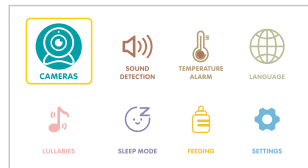
Notice:

The camera and monitor were paired already. This function is to add new cameras to the monitor.

1. Add cameras

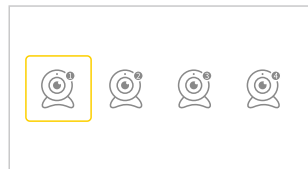
Step 1:

1. Press  to enter menu page.
2. Choose  and press OK button.



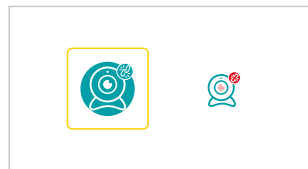
Step 2:

1. Select  then press OK button.



Step 3:

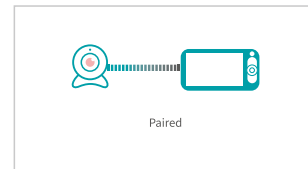
1. Select  and press OK button TWICE.
See Camera is NOT paired.
2. Press OK button to start pairing.



Step 4:

1. Press  PAIR button on the back of the camera.
2. Then see the prompted Paired.

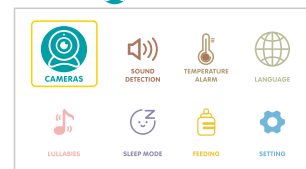
Note: Four cameras at most can be connected to one monitor.



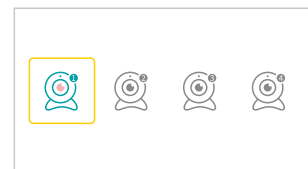
2. Delete cameras

1. Press  to enter menu page.
Choose  and press OK.

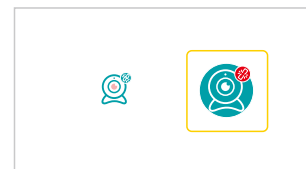


2. Select the camera need deleting.
Press OK.

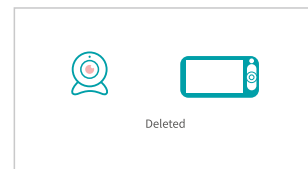


Step 2:

2. See Deleted. Your camera is deleted.



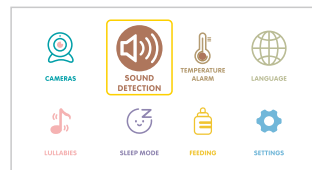
SOUND DETECTION

Explanation:

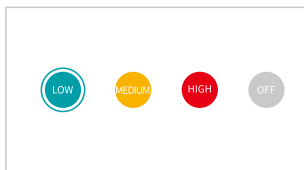
There are four options of sound detection, OFF, LOW (80dB), MEDIUM (70dB) and HIGH (65dB). OFF means you shut down the function; LOW means the sound can be detected if it reached 80dB, and so on for MEDIUM and HIGH.

Step 1:

1. Press  to enter menu page. Choose  and press OK.



2. Select the option you want. Press OK.



TEMPERATURE ALARM

Explanation:

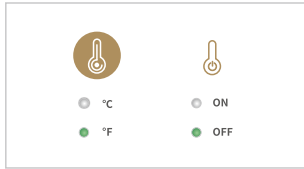
This function is to send alarms if the temperature is too low ($< 15^{\circ}\text{C}/59^{\circ}\text{F}$) or too high ($> 29^{\circ}\text{C}/84^{\circ}\text{F}$).

Step 1:

1. Press  to enter menu page. Choose  and press OK.



2. Select the option you want. Press OK.



Note: A sound/temperature alarm can be temporarily turned off by pressing any button on the monitor.

LANGUAGE

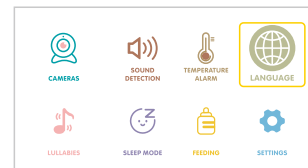
Explanation:

There are eight languages built in our device, you can choose your language here.

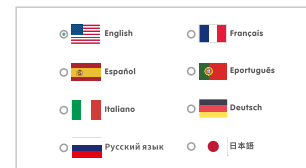
Step 1:

1. Press  to enter menu page.

2. Select your language and press OK to confirm.



LULLABIES

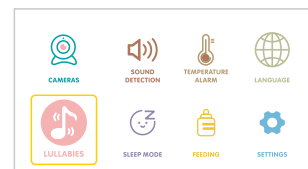
Explanation:

This function is to comfort your baby when needed.

Step 1:

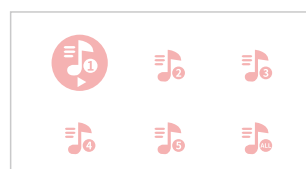
1. Press  to enter menu page.

Choose  and press OK.



2. Select the lullaby you want.

Select ALL to play the lullabies in a loop.



SLEEP MODE

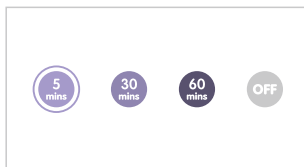
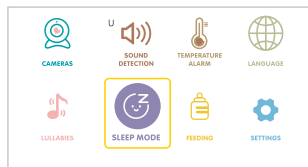
Explanation:

This function is to prolong your monitor's runtime by shutting down the screen.

Step 1:

1. Press **MENU** to enter menu page.
Choose  and press **OK**.

2. Select the time you want.
Select **OFF** to turn off Sleep Mode.



Note: The screen will automatically light up if there is a sound alarm or a temperature alarm.

FEEDING

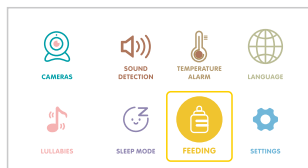
Explanation:

This function is to remind you of feeding your baby. **OFF** means you shut down the function; **2.5 hour** means it reminds you every 2.5 hours and so on for the other options.

Step 1:

1. Press **MENU** to enter menu page.
Choose  and press **OK**.

2. Select the time you want.
Select **OFF** to turn off the feeding reminder.



SETTINGS

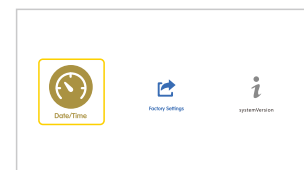
Explanation:

This function is to set Date/Time, turn on/off OSD, restore factory settings and provide service support information.

Date/Time:

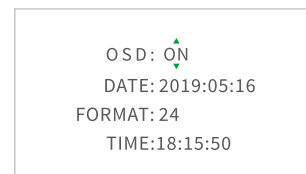
1. Press **MENU** to enter menu page.
Choose  and press **OK**.

2. Select **Date/Time**.
Press **OK** to enter the interface.



3. Press **OK** to start/finish setting.
 stands for starting the setting.

4.  stands for finishing the setting.



Note:

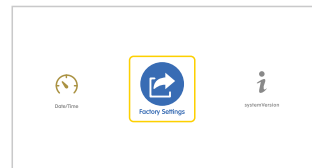
* Press Up/Down/Left/Right to select and press OK button to confirm.

* If OSD is ON, the date and time will be displayed on the status bar of the monitor; otherwise, it will not be displayed.

Restore factory settings:

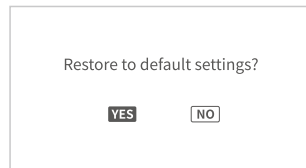

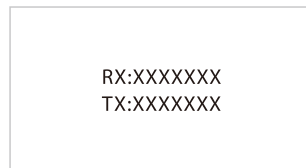
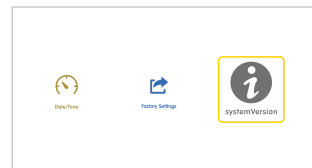

Explanation:

You can open Live-Video-Loop function through short presses on the  button until you see  on the status bar. When Live-Video-Loop function is on, the connected cameras will automatically switch every 10 seconds. And if there is a sound/temperature alarm, the camera-switch function will pause temporarily.

FAQ

Q1. Why did I fail to connect the camera to the monitor?

- * Make sure to plug the power adapter into the camera and socket firmly.
- * Make sure the camera and the monitor is within the effective distance.

Q2. Why is the live video so blurry?

- * Make sure there is no obstacle on the lens of the camera.

Q3. Why did the monitor make noise?

- * The camera and monitor may be too close. Put them further apart.

Q4. Can I hear my baby when I turn off the screen?

- * Yes. You should turn on Sound Detection, and it will wake up the screen and make a sound alarm if a loud sound is detected.

Q5. Why is the picture black and white?

- * The Night Vision Mode will be activated if the camera worked in a dark environment (Brightness $\leq$ 5 Lux).

Q6. How long will the monitor stand by with screen on?

- * The monitor can last about 5 hours, and the time of endurance varies depending on the brightness.

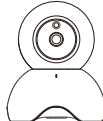
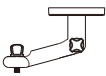

MONITOR



1. **Power/Sleep-Taste:** Lang drücken, um den Monitor ein- oder auszuschalten. kurz drücken, um den Bildschirm ein- /auszuschalten.
2. **Menü/Zurück:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Menüseite aufzurufen, oder drücken Sie sie als Zurück-Taste.
3. **Kameraschalter:** Wechselt die Kamera, wenn zwei oder mehr Kameras angeschlossen sind.
4. **Ladeanzeige:** Sie leuchtet gelb, während der Monitor geladen wird.
5. **Links:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Kamera nach links zu schwenken oder Ihre Auswahl nach links zu ändern.
6. **Nach oben:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Kamera nach oben zu neigen oder Ihre Auswahl nach oben zu ändern.
7. **Rechts:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Kamera nach rechts zu schwenken oder Ihre Auswahl nach rechts zu ändern.
8. **Nach unten:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Kamera nach unten zu neigen oder Ihre Auswahl nach unten zu ändern.
9. **Stromanzeige:** Das grüne Licht leuchtet auf, wenn Strom angeschlossen ist.
10. **Zoom/OK:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Ansicht zu vergrößern/zu verkleinern oder um Ihre Auswahl zu bestätigen.
11. **Sprechen:** Drücken Sie, um mit Ihrem Baby im Überwachungsbild zu sprechen.
12. **Schallpegel-LED:** Niedriger/hoher Pegel zeigt den von der Kamera erkannten niedrigen/hohen Ton an.
13. **Lautstärke/Helligkeit:** Drücken Sie diese Taste, um die Lautstärke oder Helligkeit des Monitors im Überwachungsbild anzupassen.
14. **Mikrofon**

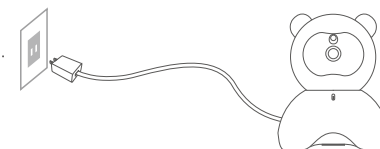

AUFLADEN

Schritt 1:

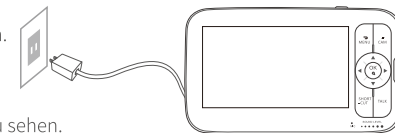
1. Schließen Sie die Kamera an den Gleichstrom Adapter an.
2. Stecken Sie den AC-Adapter in eine Steckdose.

Hinweis: Stellen Sie die Kamera nicht in der Nähe Ihres Babys auf (mindestens 1 m Abstand).



Schritt 2:

1. Schließen Sie den Monitor an den Gleichstromadapter an.
2. Stecken Sie den AC-Adapter in eine Steckdose.
3. Halten Sie die Ein-/Aus-Taste lange gedrückt um den Monitor anzuschalten und das zu überwachende Areal zu sehen.



Hinweis: Das vollständige Aufladen des Monitors dauert 4 Stunden. Und es hält ungefähr 4 - 5 Stunden.

KAMERA EINSTELLUNGEN
