After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) For this type of device, the response to antenna connection provided has been previously accepted by the FCC after discussions with Joe Dichoso (Previous Device FCC ID: NTAMMR1), as long as the manufacturer does not provide information to the users on how to remove the antenna and the unit is shipped from the factory already installed. Please note that the new users manual provided explains how to remove/install the antennas. The following information is from previous application FCC ID: NTAEMMR1

I had a discussion with the FCC today regarding the antenna connector issue. The FCC is willing to accept the antenna connector as long as it is covered as provided in the photograph from the factory/manufacture. They are concerned that the user should not be given any instructions regarding installation/removal of the antenna cover or the antenna itself.

To meet this requirement we will require a new manual with references to the professional installation of the antenna removed and an attestation that the unit will be fully assembled (including the antenna and cover) at the factory/manufacture. Since the antenna will not be considered to have a connector external to the unit, and that it is not used by the average end user, professional installation becomes a mute point.

Please adjust the manual accordingly.
