

Radiated Emission: The sample was placed 0.8m (below 1GHz)/1.5m (above 1GHz) above the ground plane of 3m chamber*. Measurements in both horizontal and vertical polarities were performed. During the test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, rotating the turntable, varying antenna height from 1m to 4m in both horizontal and vertical polarizations. The emissions worst-case are shown in Test Results of the following pages.

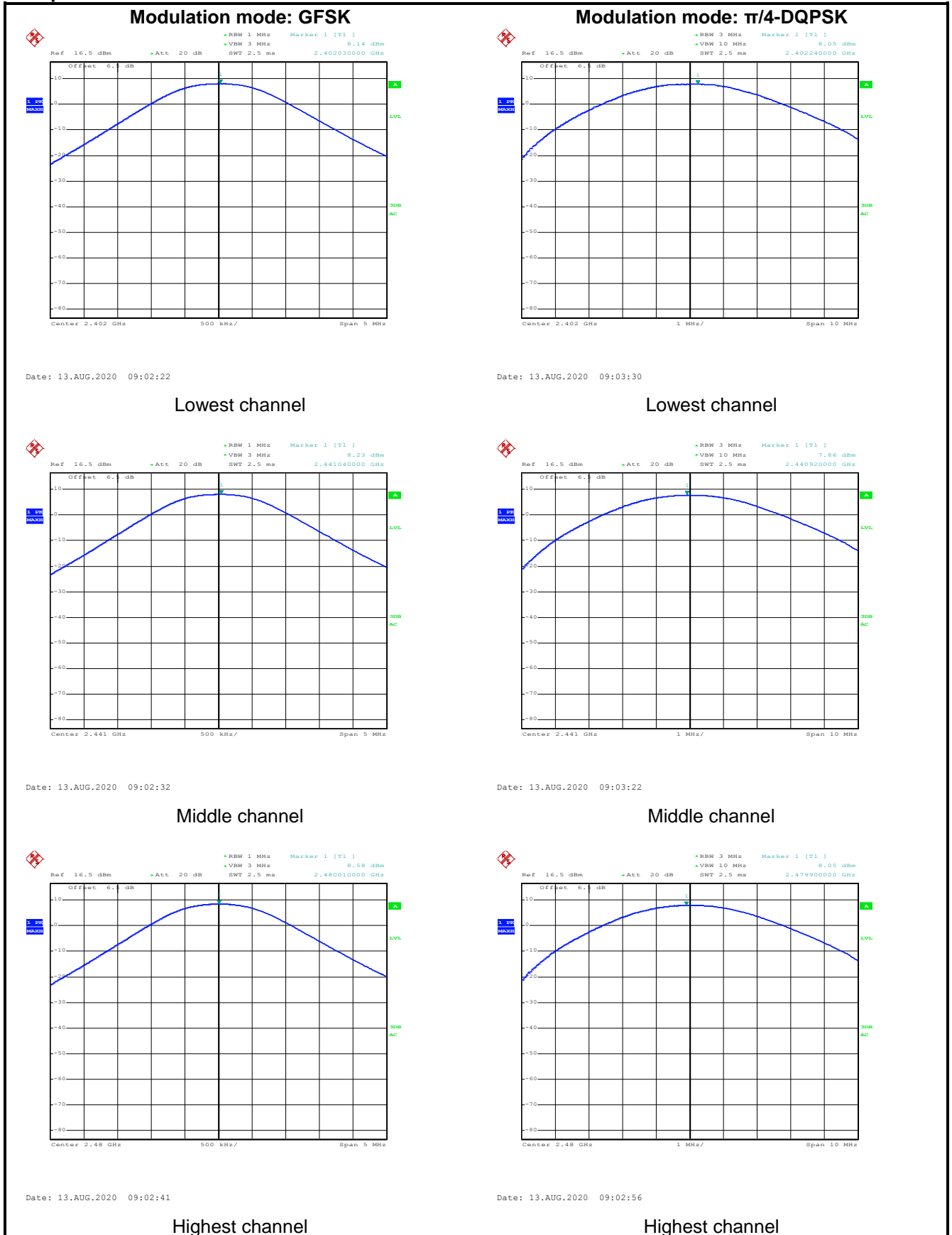

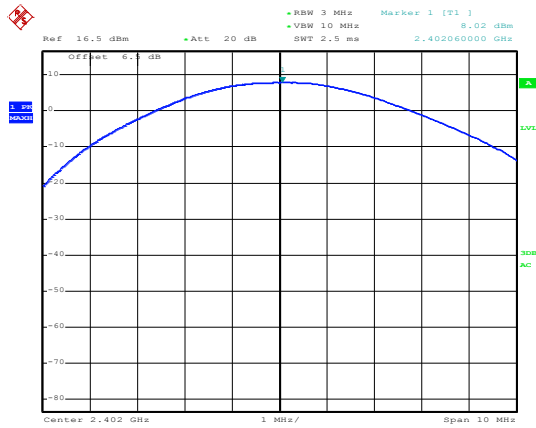

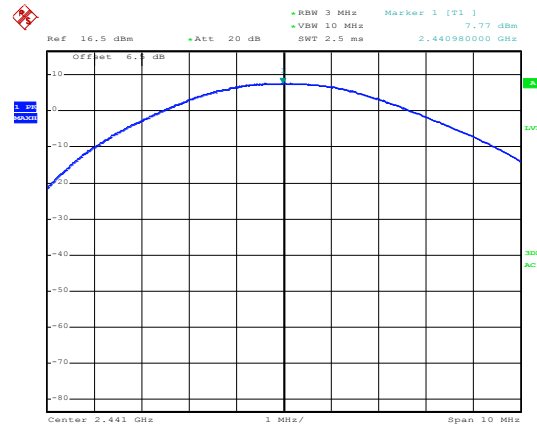


Modulation mode: 8DPSK



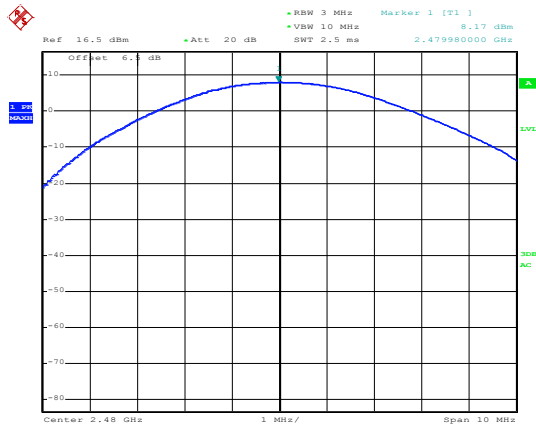


Middle channel

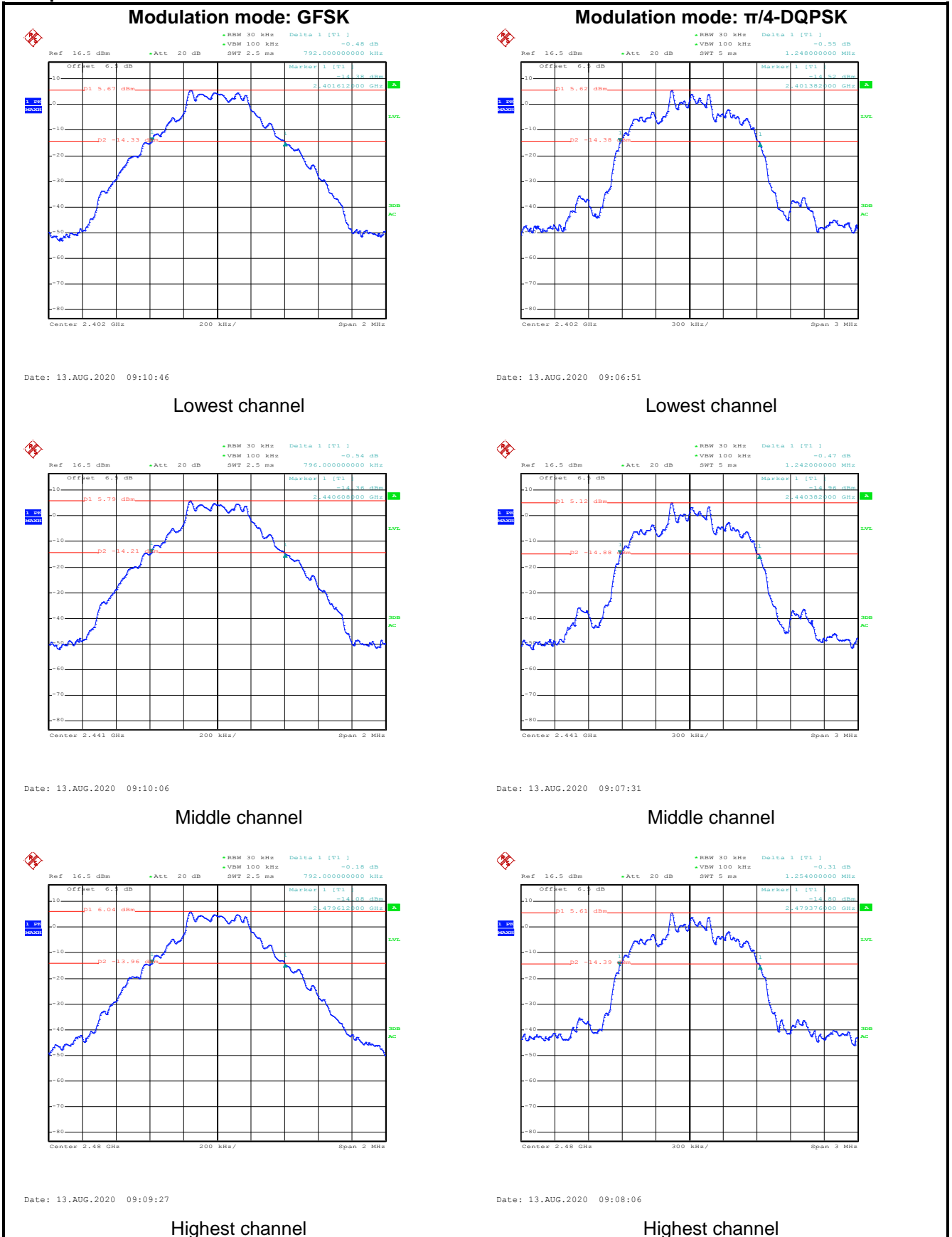
