After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) We submitted the Grantee code request to the FCC, but the FCC will require further information as detailed under a separate email? Please provide this information as quickly as possible so that we can forward to the FCC. In order to grant this under BenQ Corporation the FCC will have to adjust the data base first.
- 2) With respect to the diversity issue, the EUT in this application already shows 2 antennas. Please be more specific by answering the following:
 - a) Is the device capable of selecting either antenna to transmit with?
 - b) Only one set of data was provided. If the device may selectively use either antenna, then information must be provided regarding the specific test methodology or engineering judgement made for purposes of determining which antenna path was selected for testing or alternatively test data for the second antenna may be submitted.
- 3) On the RF exposure exhibit
 - a) adjust the classification from "portable" to "portable &/or mobile"
- 4) Please add the following sentence to the MPE statements contained in the manual:
"This device must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter"
