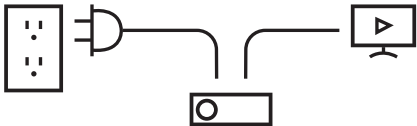
Let’s get started.

Stream TV

Before you set up your Stream TV, you’ll need to make the proper connections.

- 1 Make sure you have a Wi-Fi internet connection near your setup location.
- 2 Connect the HDMI cable from the Stream TV to your TV.
- 3 Connect the power cord from the Stream TV to an electrical outlet.
- 4 Turn on your TV and set it to the correct HDMI input.

Optional: Use the provided bracket to mount the device on a wall.



Once connected, follow the setup instructions shown on the TV screen.
