Operating instructions</div><div>Side button/Multifunctional digital crown</div><div><div>Long press</div><div>Press and hold the side button for 3 seconds to turn ON/OFF the watch.</div><div>Short press</div><div>When the screen is off, press the button lightly to turn on the screen.</div><div>On the watch main interface, press the button lightly to enter the "main menu" interface.</div><div>On any other interface, press the button lightly to return to the watch "main" interface.</div></div><div></div></div> <div><div>1.3. Function description</div><div><div>Turn up and down</div><div>In the watch "main" interface, turn the digital crown up and down to switch between shortcuts cards.</div><div>In other interfaces, turn the digital crown up and down to slide the list up and down.</div></div><div></div><div><div>1.3.1. Watch main interface</div><div>Swipe right or left to enter Qwatch player/alar/timer or notification/tash reminder/sleeping monitoring/WeimerSPQ2/HR/Steps counter shortcuts cards.</div><div></div><div></div><div>Swipe down to enter the shortcuts bar.</div><div>Swipe up to check the messages notifications.</div></div></div> <div><div>1.3.2. Shortcuts bar</div><div><div>Display adjustment (screen lighting and screen sleep)</div><div>Find my phone (required phone connecting)</div><div>Volume level adjustment</div><div>Do not disturb mode switch</div><div>Watch settings</div><div>Raise wrist to wake up screen switch</div></div></div>	<div><div>1.3.3. Main menu</div><div><div>Phone: you can make/cover phone calls using your watch (required phone connecting).</div><div>Messages: notifications connect your phone to receive sms and social media notifications (required phone connecting).</div><div>Qwatch player: listen to audio files including morning and evening remembrance.</div><div>Prayer notifications: receive five prayer notifications based on your location.</div><div>Azkar: you can check your daily azkar using your watch.</div><div>Tasah reminders: 49 in 99 Names with explanation of each and hijr calendar and more.</div><div>Heart rate/SPQ2: keep following your health records and blood oxygen percentage.</div><div>Alarm/timer/watch/timer are also daily tools that you may need.</div></div></div> <div><div>2. Binding Qwatch</div><div><div>2.1. How to download IQIBLA Life APP</div><div>Scan the QR code displayed when turning on the watch or scan the QR code to the App Store.</div><div></div><div><div>iPhone:</div><div>Scan the QR code, click the App Store to download, or search for "IQIBLA Life" in the App Store.</div><div>Android Phone:</div><div>Scan the QR code, enter "google play" to download, if there is no "google play", use the local store to download.</div></div><div></div></div></div> <div><div>2.2. Binding Qwatch</div><div></div><div><div>1. Register a new account in IQIBLA.</div><div>2. Press on "Add device" and choose "Scan" to add the watch to your list of devices.</div><div>3. After the watch is turned on, scan the QR code in the watch interface.</div><div>4. Complete Qwatch binding.</div></div><div><small>Note: Qwatch can only be bind with one account. If you want to bind it to another account, you must need to unlink it from the first account.</small></div></div> <div><div>2.3. Unbinding Qwatch</div><div></div><div><div>1. Enter "Settings" in the device interface in IQIBLA Life APP.</div><div>2. Click on "Unbind" then "Next".</div><div>3. Insert the code to complete unbinding.</div></div><div><small>Note: after the unbinding is completed, you need to unpair in the Bluetooth settings of the mobile phone.</small></div></div>
