
BT56 wireless headset

Product Overview:

BT56 features the latest 5.4 chipset, leveraging 5.4+EDR technology for exceptional signal transmission and ultra-low power consumption. It supports all wireless devices and has an automatic answer function. When calls come in, there's no need to answer manually—safe and efficient. Equipped with a premium 40mm strong magnetic speaker, it delivers powerful stereo sound quality.

Powering On/Off:

Press the power symbol button " o " for 2–3 seconds to power on. The indicator light will alternate between red and blue flashes, indicating the device is on. To power off, press the same button " o " for 2–3 seconds, whereupon you'll hear an English voice prompt. After powering off, the light will no longer illuminate.

Connecting Two Phones Simultaneou

After turning on the wireless headphones, connect them to phone A first. Then, turn off the wireless settings of phone A. Next, connect the headphones phone B. After the connection is successful, turn on the wireless settings of phone A again. Now, both phones will be connected at the same time

How to Connect to a Phone:

After turning on, the indicator light will alternate flashing red and blue. At this time, turn on the mobile phone's wireless switch and search for devices. Find "BT56" in the list, and after a few seconds of connection, it will be successfully paired. After airing, when the mobile phone's switch and the headset are both turned on, the headset will automatically connect in subsequent use.

Volume Adjustment / Song Switch:

Turn the knob to the left to decrease the volume, and to the right to increase it. Press " | " to play the previous track, and press " | " to skip to the next

Answering Calls:

When a call comes in, the device will automatically answer after four ringtone sounds. Alternatively, press the " " button to answer the call.

Charging the Product:

The product will prompt with a voice message when the battery is low. It takes about 3 hours to fully charge. The red light will illuminate during charging and turn off once fully charged.















Helmet installation instructions











Use a hard object to push inside the round hole to remove the clip

The installation of left speaker:



Peel off white release paper from reserved round hook fastener



Peel off white release paper from reserved round hook fastener and attach to helmet's ear area.



Refer to left image for installation. Place speaker at ear position, and find suitable spot for microphone arm.

The installation of right speaker:

Peel off white release paper from reserved round hook fastener.



The reserved round hook-and-loop fastener, after peeling off the white release paper, can be affixed to the speaker at its determined position.



The left and right speaker connection wires are to be concealed within the inner lining.

Precautions for using the helmet Bluetooth
