
Buttons and Features



Buttons and Features

1	Vol-	Press once to decrease the volume of the speaker. Press and hold to play the previous song.		
2	Power / Play / Pause	Press once to play the music. Press again to pause. Press and hold to turn the device on/ off.		
3	Vol+	Press once to increase the volume of the speaker. Press and hold to play the next song.		
4	Mode	Press once to switch between the following modes: Bluetooth® / Memory Card / USB / AUX. Press and hold to turn the LED lights on/off. Press twice to change the light effect.		
5	Indicator Light	This light indicates that the speaker is on.		
6	Charging Port	Connects to charging cable.		
7	USB Port	Connect to a USB device (sold separately).		
8	3.5mm AUX Port	Connect to external device using an AUX cable.		

Buttons and Features

9	Memory Card	Insert Memory Card here (sold separately).
10	Power	Press once to play music. Press again to pause the music. Press and hold for 2-3 seconds to turn the microphone on/off. Press twice to cycle between the 6 different voice effects.
11	Vol+ Vol-	Press once to increase/decrease the microphone's volume. Press and hold to play the next/ previous song.
12	Karaoke	Press to turn Karaoke Mode on/off. Press and hold to dodge (the device will automatically adjust the volume according to input).
13	Indicator Light	This light indicates that the microphone is turned on.
14	Charging Port	Connects to the charging cable.

Note: Using the Vol+/- buttons on the microphone will increase/decrease the voice volume coming from the microphone. You can adjust the volume of the music separately using the volume controls on your connected external device (mobile phone/tablet/MP3 player).

Charging Your Speaker and Microphone

Use the included USB-C® charging cable to connect your speaker/microphone to power. (Note: The USB-C® end of the cable should be connected to your speaker/microphone while the USB 2.0 end of the cable is connected to a power source.)



The indicator light on the speaker/microphone will turn red, indicating the device is charging. The light will turn off when the device is fully charged.


Setting Up Your Device (Bluetooth Mode)

- 1. Press and hold the **Power button** on your speaker to turn it
- 2. Press and hold the **Power button** on your microphone to turn it on. The microphone and speaker will automatically pair with each other.
- 3. Press the **Mode button** on your speaker to enter Bluetooth® Mode. You will hear the voice prompt "Bluetooth®" indicating you are in Bluetooth® mode.
- 4. On your external device (mobile phone/tablet/MP3 player), search for the Bluetooth® network "KRMC200MC" and connect to it.
- 5. Once successfully connected, you are ready to play music from your external device.

AUX Mode and USB Mode

You may play music from an external device connected to the speaker via USB or AUX cables (sold separately).

To do this, simply connect your device to the speaker using the appropriate cable, then press the **Mode button** on your speaker to navigate to USB Mode or AUX Mode. You will hear a voice prompt indicating the mode you are in. You may then start playing music from your external device.



Memory Card Mode

To play music from a memory card:

- 1. Press and hold the **Power button** on your speaker to turn it
- 2. Press and hold the **Power button** on your microphone to turn it on. The microphone and speaker will automatically pair with each other.
- 3. To play music from a memory card (sold separately), insert the card into the **Memory Card slot** on your speaker. The speaker will automatically switch to Memory Card Mode.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Recommended Steps
No Bluetooth® connection	 Press the Mode button on your speaker to enter Bluetooth® mode and reconnect to your Bluetooth® device. Try adjusting the distance between the speaker and the bluetooth device. The speaker may already be connected to a different device. Turn off Bluetooth® from the previously connected device before pairing to a new device.
There is no sound coming from the microphone	 Make sure your microphone is charged and turned on. The speaker and microphone may not have successfully paired. Please turn both devices off, then back on.
There is no music coming from the speaker	 Check whether Bluetooth® was successfully paired. Check if the sound was paused from the microphone. If so, press the Power button on the microphone to play the music. Check if the volume on your external Bluetooth® device is turned up. Check if the volume on your speaker or microphone is turned up.

Problem	Recommended Steps			
There is noise interference	 Adjust the distance between the speaker and your external Bluetooth® device. Adjust the distance between the microphone and the speaker. 			
Device won't power on	Make sure your device is charged.
