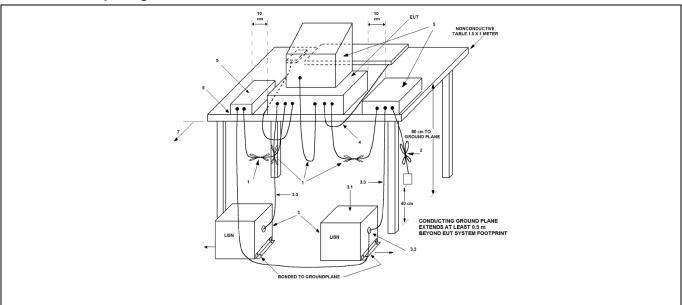

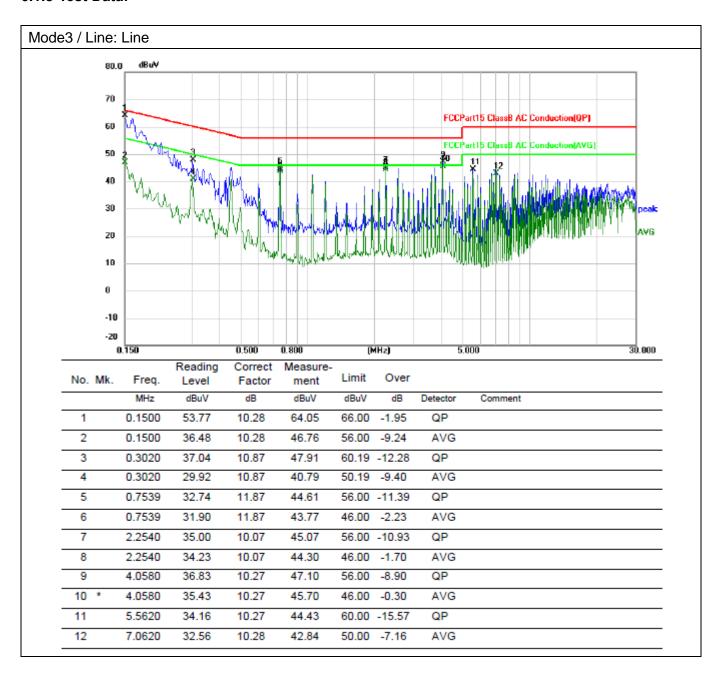

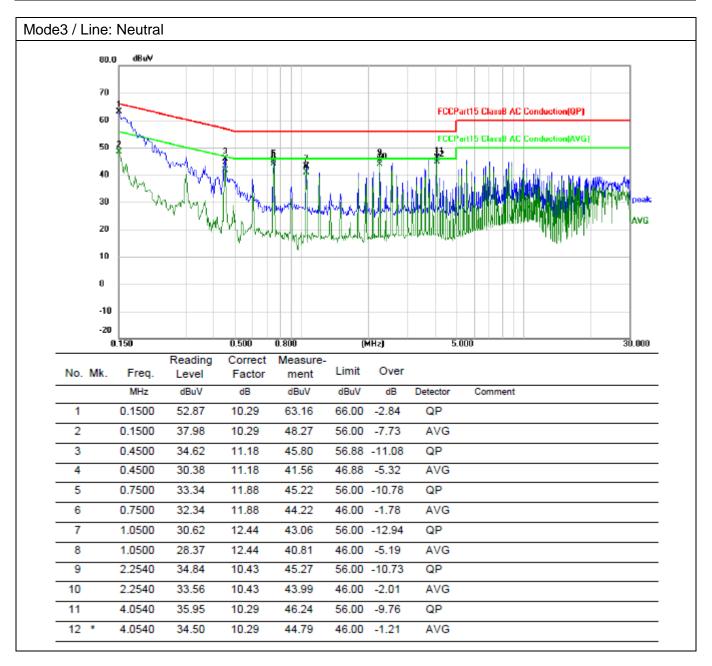
6.1.2 Test Setup Diagram:

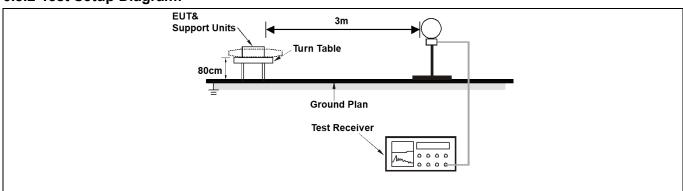

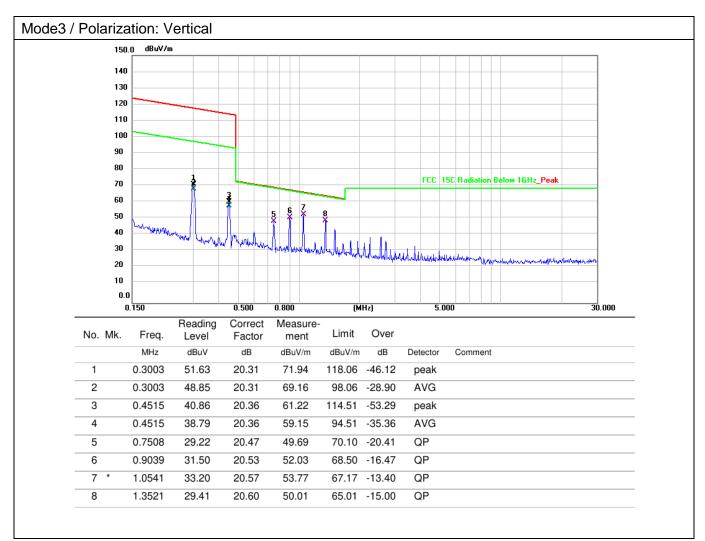
6.3.2 Test Setup Diagram:

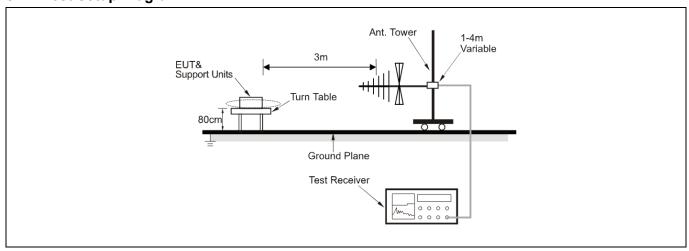

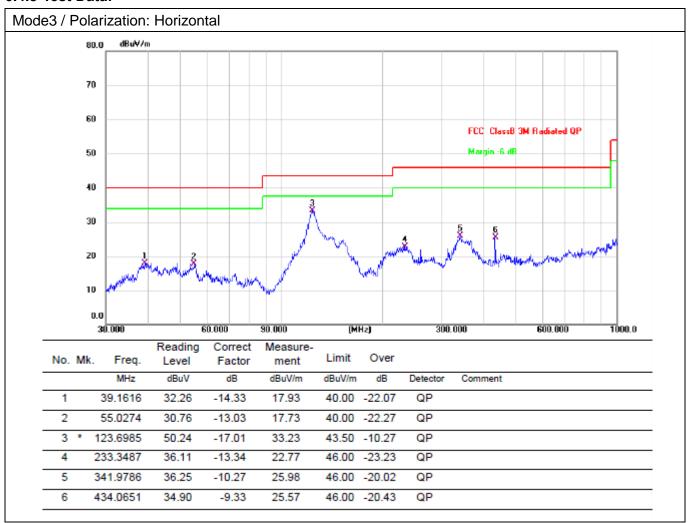

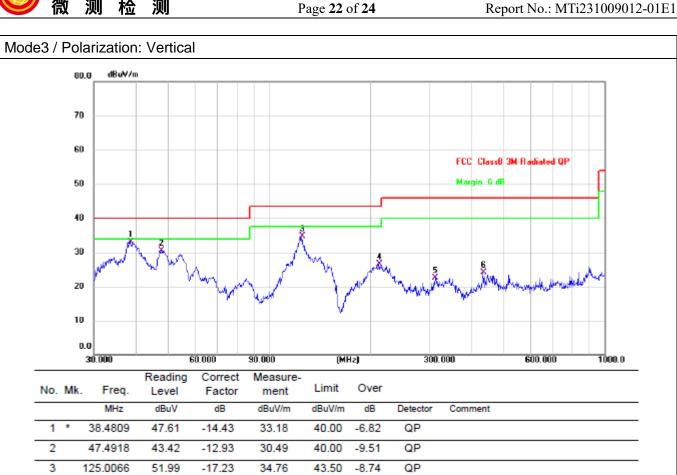
