Wi-Fi Setup Instructions

WIFI settings

Scan QR code of Figure 1 , then download and install "LIBOS HOME" APP or Search for LIBOS HOME on the App Store or Android App platforms. Then, download and install it.

Open the "LIBOS HOME" App and log in. There are two ways to log in: by verification code or by password.




01. Use a screwdriver to take out the 9 screws on the bottom case.


Intelligent cleaning adjustment



Both the dustbin and the primary filter can be washed directly with water, which does not require much labor on your part, and washing the dustbin with water can avoid flying dust!

4.1 Precautions




When the host is working, please help and remove unfriendly obstacles in the work. Arrange the tables, chairs and other furniture and home appliances in the home neatly, and the host will clean it smoothly and return you a clean and new home.




If the main engine performs tasks at the entrance of the stairs, the edge of the steps, or the entrance of the narrow area between the furniture, please place a protective fence to ensure its safety and smooth operation.

Instructions for use



Please do not stand in narrow places such as thresholds and aisles, so as to prevent the host from missing scans.

When the host is performing work, please ensure that no objects with the lowest edge less than 1.8 cm are placed in the cleaning area to prevent the host from climbing and getting stuck.




Power cords, toys and other sundries scattered on the ground may trip or entangle the host, please remove the sundries carefully. The robot has a carpet recognition function. When the machine is equipped with a mop, when it encounters a carpet, it can automatically lift the mop for vacuuming.


4.2 Operation Guide

Assemble the base station



Align the washable tray with the installation position of the base station, push it into the base station, and press the buckles on both sides to fix the washable tray.



and add an appropriate amount of clean water (4500ml is recommended). Cover the clean water tank cover and align it with the base station to complete the installation.



Open the top cover, insert the dust bag guide plate into the dust bag stop of the base station, and the dust bag handle should be fully inserted into the dust bag guide plate. Close the top cover.




Peel off the cleaning fluid sealing sticker, open the top cover of the base station and insert the cleaning fluid vertically. Then close the top cover


Place the base station flat against the wall, do not place objects within 1M to the left and right and 2M in front, and do not have objects with strong reflective surfaces such as mirrors. Then connect the power.



Long press the power button of the machine to turn on the machine, all the lights are on, and enter the waiting command mode. If there is no operation on the machine within 10 minutes, the machine will enter sleep mode.



Power on and charge



Press and hold the power button of the sweeper to turn on the machine. In any mode, press the "Recharge" button on the main unit or the "Recall" button on the base station to automatically recharge the sweeper. You can also click the recharge button on the APP to make the machine recharge automatically.




This product complies with European ERP energy loss standards.

When the cleaning is completed or the battery is too low, the machine will automatically start looking for a charging base to charge.
Please keep the charging base powered on, otherwise the machine will not be able to find the base for charging.

Base station touch buttons and display



Click the base station self-cleaning button. (If the sweeper is in the base station, it will exit the base station about 50cm to enter the waiting command mode.) The base station will add water to the cleaning tank for self-cleaning, and will automatically drain the sewage after cleaning. After the start of self-cleaning, every time you click the self-cleaning button, the base station will switch between "add water to the cleaning tank" and "drain the sewage" once.

(If the sweeper does not operate in 10 minutes while waiting for command mode, the machine will enter sleep mode.)



Click on the sweeper to start cleaning, and click on the sweeper again during the cleaning process to pause cleaning



Tap the sweeper to return to the base station for charging in any mode. Click again in the process of returning to the base station, the machine will suspend recharging and enter the waiting command mode.


Press and hold at the same time to turn off the child lock. All buttons on the sweeper and base station are locked. APP control is not affected. Press and hold again at the same time to turn off the child lock. When the child lock is turned on, all buttons on the sweeper and base station are locked. APP control is not affected. Long press again

Charging Precautions

01. When using the machine for the first time, please let the machine run out of power.
02. Please charge the machine for 12 hours for the first time. When the machine is charging, the recharge button will flash. When the charging is completed, the control button light will be on.
03. If you do not use the machine for a long time, please press and hold the power button to turn off the sweeper.
04. After the power is used up, please recharge the machine as soon as possible.
05. This product can only use the charging base station equipped with the factory.
06. The battery will be repaired and replaced by the after-sales department.

Key Function



Long press  to switch between power on and off, short press after power on to switch between start cleaning and pause cleaning.



Long press  to activate host hotspot for network configuration.



After powering  on, short press the main unit to start recharging.


Sleep

Sleep mode means that the machine is in a stopped state, and the control button lights are off. In standby mode, if there is no operation on the machine for 10 minutes, the machine will automatically enter sleep mode. Note: If the machine will not be used for a long time, please turn off the machine.



For the first time, you can activate the APP to quickly build a Figure function, the machine will independently explore the indoor environment, and the fastest 8 minutes to build a 100 square meter Figure.


planning cleaning



The machine will perform intelligent multi-zoning according to the room environment. First extend an area and then carry out the bow-shaped planning and cleaning. Line laser and infrared sensor fusion obstacle avoidance can accurately avoid common indoor objects; ToF along the wall can be as close to the wall as possible to avoid missing the wall



Draw a restricted area



It is only applicable to APP operation, and the restricted area is divided on the APP, and the sweeper will automatically avoid the area.

laser repositioning



During the cleaning process, move the sweeper after a pause, and then restart it, the sweeper will seek repositioning, if the positioning is successful, the sweeper will continue to clean, if it fails, empty the Figure and clean again

Instructions for use

other modes

Connect APP to open more modes

Single mopping mode: The machine only mops the floor (the side brush and the roller brush are turned on, and the fan is not turned on).

Single sweeping mode: raise the mop, turn on the side brush, roller brush and fan.

Sweeping and mopping integrated mode: Turn on the fan, side brush, and roller brush, and the mop fits the ground, applying pressure or rotating.


Carpet avoidance mode: when it is turned on: when cleaning (three modes), the carpet is not cleaned. When it is turned off: In the sweeping and single mopping modes, lift the mop to clean the floor and turn off the water tank at the same time; in the sweeping mode, directly put on the carpet; after laying down the carpet, restore the previous cleaning settings.

Carpet booster mode: [Switch] Increase the fan gear to Max when cleaning the carpet.

(Single mopping mode and sweeping and mopping integrated mode, the machine needs to be equipped with a mop to start. When it encounters a carpet, it will automatically lift the mop, stop the rotation of the mop, turn off the water tank, and avoid wetting the carpet. When entering, pausing, and exiting, there will be a voice broadcast.) Users can adjust according to the actual situation.

5.1 Side brush cleaning and replacement




Check the condition of the side brush from time to time to see if it is damaged or entangled with foreign objects. Clean the side brush with a cleaning tool or a rag. When the side brush is damaged and cannot be used, please replace it in time. L and R correspond to each other.







Lift the dust box handle up and take out the dust box.




Open the flip cover of the dust box, and take out the Hypa bracket, HEPA filter and Hypa silica gel. It is not recommended to wash the high-efficiency filter, please tap it to remove dust




After rinsing the dust box, shake the water from the dust outlet vigorously.



Dry the dust box and filter material components and keep them dry to ensure their service life. When the dust box is used for 15-30 days, it is recommended to wash it once. The maximum service life of the high-efficiency filter is 3 months.




Reinstall the Hypa bracket, Hypa silica gel and high-efficiency filter back into the dust box. Before installing the filter, please ensure that the primary filter and the high-efficiency filter in the dust box are in a dry state. Do not expose the high-efficiency filter and the primary filter to the sun.







5.3 Maintenance of mop components



Lift up the rear of the machine and press firmly on the mop assembly to remove it. Prevent water on the mop from seeping inside the machine and causing damage.




Peel the soaked mop off the mop holder. Then rinse and dry the water seepage mop.


Open the top cover, pinch the handle of the dust bag and pull it up, so that the dust bag is detached from the base station. Then follow the step of placing the dust bag and replace with a new dust bag.


Open the top cover, lift up the sewage tank vertically, and take out the sewage tank.






Hold the elastic buckle of the roller brush cover with your hands, and pull up to open the roller brush cover assembly




Take out the roller brush shaft, and clean the sundries and hair on the roller brush shaft.

5.6 Maintenance of other components



Occasionally use a cleaning tool or a dry soft cloth to gently wipe the machine chassis sensor window and carpet detection window, as well as the charging electrode sheet on the back of the machine.



Clean the terminals of the charging stand with a dry cleaning tool or a soft cloth after power off

Common malfunctions

6.1 Fault description

Host failure description

Fault conditions	Possible Causes	solution
The host cannot be charged	The host and the charging pole of the base station are not in full contact.	Make sure that the main unit is fully connected to the charging pole piece of the charging base station.
	The power of the charging base station is turned off, and the power switch of the main unit is turned on, resulting in power consumption.	When the main unit is not performing work, it is recommended to keep it in a charging state, so as to better carry out the next work.
Stuck when host works	The main unit is hindered by entanglement of scattered wires on the ground, drooping curtains or carpet fringes.	The host will try various methods to get out of trouble independently. If it fails to get out of trouble, it is recommended to help manually.
The cleaning is not completed, the host returns to charge	The main unit can sense the lack of power when it is working, and it will automatically return to charging.	Charge the host.
	Wooden floors, ceramic tiles and other flat ground hosts work at different speeds and for different periods of time.	The working time of the host varies with the complexity of the room, the amount of garbage and the cleaning mode.
The host does not automatically clean according to the scheduled time	The host power switch is not turned on, and the host cannot work by itself according to the agreed time when it is turned off.	Turn on the host power switch.
	The power of the main unit is low.	When the host is in standby, it should be kept charging on the charging stand to ensure that it has sufficient power to work at any time.
	The host components are clogged and entangled with garbage.	Turn off the power, clean the dust box and turn the bottom of the host up. Clean each part separately.
When the main machine is working, there are phenomena such as missed scanning, chaotic routes, deviation, and irregular and untidy display of the cleaning Figure on the APP side.	It may be that when the main engine climbs small steps, thresholds, and door bars, the driving wheel and the ground slip, which affects the main engine's judgment on the working environment of the whole house.	It is recommended to close the door to the area and clean the area separately. The main unit has the function of independently identifying single rooms, and it will return to the starting point after cleaning, so please feel free to use it.



	The tray is full of dirty water.	Click the self-cleaning button on the base station body to switch to the water suction mode. After the water in the tray is sucked away, the self-cleaning will start again.
	The tray is not installed correctly.	Check whether the buckles on the left and right ends of the tray are in place.
Tray water overflow	The base station tray was not installed properly, causing water leaks.	Install the base station tray correctly.
	The tray full sensor is clogged with dirt.	Remove the tray and wash the tray manually.
Unable to suck up tray sewage	Recovery tank not installed properly.	Correctly install the recovery tank.
