Product description

This is kit for choosing our products.

This product is a smart wireless microphone that provides professional-grade recording output, Plug and Play, no APP required.

FullFunction: It can be used in video broadcast, video shooting, program interview, live-stream recording, video teaching and other scenarios.

The wireless radio microphone consists of two parts, the microphone transmitter and the receiver, (As shown below)

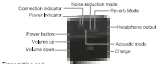


(Microphone transmitter)

Transmitter key: long press 2S to switch on and off, the connection indicator light will flash three times to power on. Long press to switch on/off, long press to power on/off, long press to power on/off.

Receiver key: long press 2S to switch on and off, the connection indicator light will flash three times to power on. Long press to switch on/off, long press to power on/off, long press to power on/off.

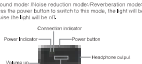
Volume key: This is a kind of microphone in reduced, and the connection indicator light will flash.

FullFunction voice broadcast:
Power indicator light: long press 2S to switch on and off, the connection indicator light will flash three times to power on. Long press to switch on/off, long press to power on/off, long press to power on/off.

Conductor indicator: The conductor indicator light will flash during the recording, and the power indicator light will flash when the power is on. Press the power button to turn on the power, and the connection indicator light will flash.

Microphone indicator: The microphone indicator light will flash during the recording, and the power indicator light will flash when the power is on. Press the power button to turn on the power, and the connection indicator light will flash.

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Instructions

1. How to connect a mobile phone to record high-quality audio

1.1) Press and hold the receiver RX and transmitter TX for ten seconds to power on, and the pairing is successful.

1.2) Press the power button of the transmitter TX to switch the corresponding mode (original sound mode > voice reduction mode > voice reduction mode), and then open the camera and other apps in the phone to record and video.

2. The operation method of connecting the mobile phone live broadcast

2.1) Press and hold the receiver RX and transmitter TX for ten seconds to power on, and the pairing is successful. (Picture 1)

2.2) Connect the receiver RX to the camera with a cable. (Picture 2)

2.3) Press the power button of the transmitter TX to switch the corresponding mode (original sound mode > voice reduction mode > voice reduction mode), and then open the live broadcast app in the mobile phone to broadcast live.

2.4) The transmitter TX can be clipped into the monitor headphones to monitor the sound recorded by yourself.

3. Connect the camera to record video

3.1) Press and hold the receiver RX and transmitter TX for ten seconds to power on, and the connection is successful. (Picture 1)

3.2) Connect the receiver RX to the camera with a cable. (Picture 2)

3.3) Press the power button of the transmitter TX to switch the corresponding mode (original sound mode > voice reduction mode > voice reduction mode), and then open the camera and other apps in the phone to record and video.

3.4) The transmitter TX can be clipped into the monitor headphones to monitor the sound recorded by yourself.
