



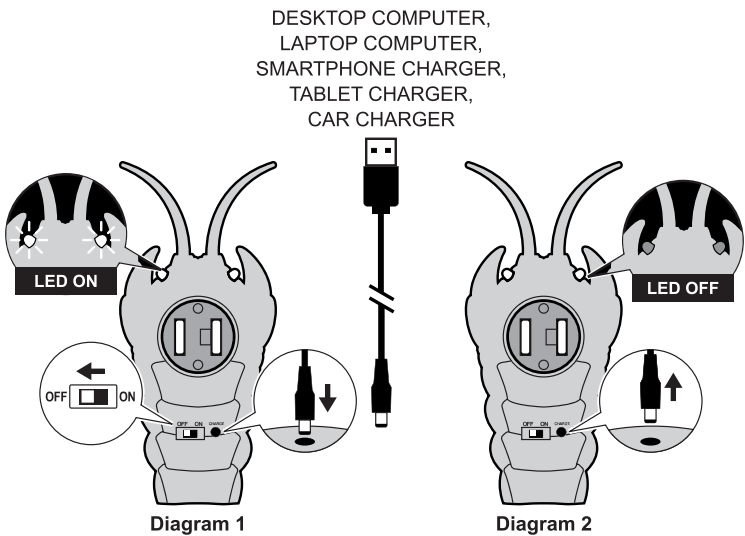
GIANT R/C CENTIPEDE

- CONTENTS :**
- 1 x R/C Centipede with built-in non-replaceable rechargeable battery
 - 1 x Transmitter
 - 1 x USB charging cable

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

CENTIPEDE
The Centipede is powered by a built-in non-replaceable rechargeable battery. The included rechargeable battery is not charged prior to shipment and must be charged before the first use.

- Charging The Centipede**
1. Make sure the Centipede's ON/OFF switch is in the OFF position. (See Diagram 1.)
 2. Plug the charging cable jack to the charging socket at the underside of the Centipede.
 3. Plug the charging cable USB socket to an USB certified port, i.e., desktop computer / laptop computer / smartphone charger / tablet charger / car charger.
 4. The LED lights will stay ON to show it is charging.
 5. Once the LED lights turned OFF, the Centipede is fully charged. Unplug the USB charging cable (See Diagram 2.)



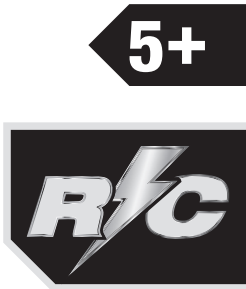
- Caution : Built-In Battery Safety Information**
1. The Centipede includes a non-replaceable battery. Do not open, disassemble or alter the Centipede in anyway.
 2. Adult supervision is required when charging the Centipede.
 3. Charge battery in isolated area. Keep away from flammable materials.
 4. Do not expose to direct sunlight.
 5. Do not recharge the toy if it is hot. Allow it to cool before recharge.
 6. Do not allow the batteries to get wet.
 7. Carefully read the instruction guide and use the batteries correctly.
 8. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
 9. Routine examination for damage to the plug, enclosure and other parts. In the event of any damage, the toy must not be used with USB port until the damage has been repaired.
 10. This toy is not intended for children under 3 years old.

- TRANSMITTER**
1. Unscrew the battery-compartment cover to open.
 2. Insert two AAA/LR3 batteries by matching (+) and (-) sign as indicated in the battery compartment. (See Diagram 3.)
 3. Replace the battery-compartment cover, and screw it closed.

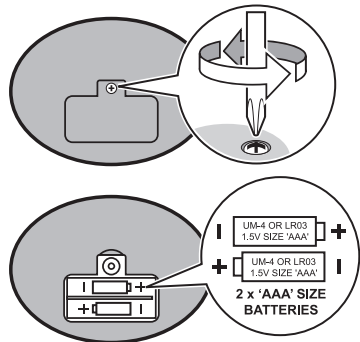

HOW TO PLAY

- TO BEGIN**
1. Push the Centipede's ON/OFF switch to the "ON" position. (See Diagram 4.)

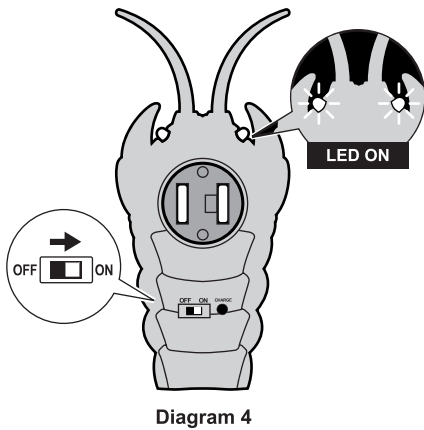

- RUNNING FORWARD**
1. Press both "LEFT" and "RIGHT" buttons at the same time for forward motion. (See Diagram 5.)

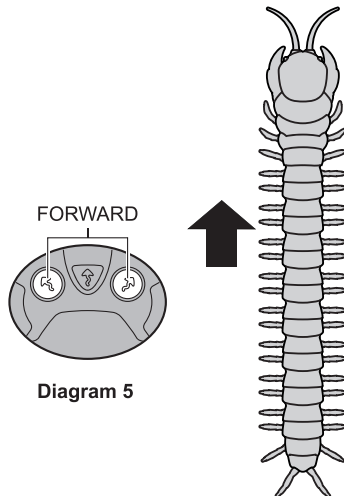

- TURNING**
1. Press "LEFT" button to turn left. (See Diagram 6.)
 2. Press "RIGHT" button to turn right. (See Diagram 7.)

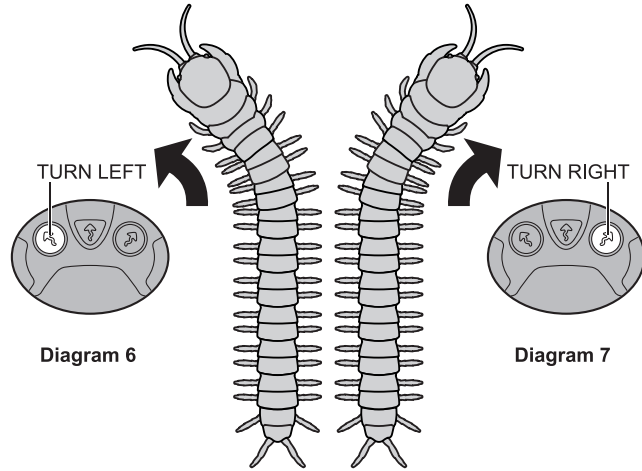

- S-SHAPED MOVEMENT**
1. Press the middle button for "S-Shaped Movement". (See Diagram 8.)

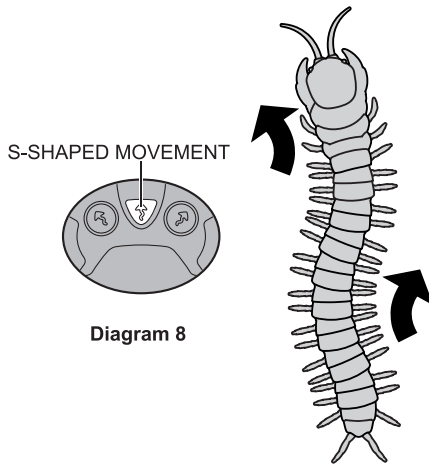

- TO STOP OPERATION**
1. Release all buttons to make the Centipede stop. (See Diagram 9.)

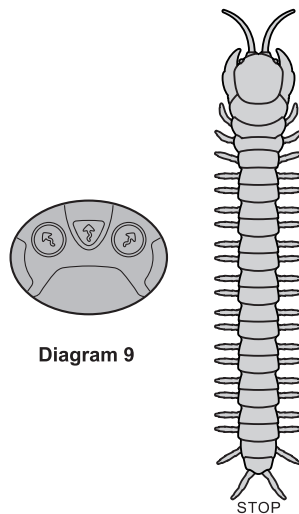

- PERFORMANCE TIPS:**
- Do not operate on grass, sand or carpet.
 - Keep toy away from water.
 - Use fresh alkaline batteries.
 - After every 15 minutes of operation, be sure to rest toy at least 30 minutes.
 - When not in use, make sure toy's ON/OFF switch is in the OFF position.
 - Do not bend antenna.
 - Electrical or CB interference, mobile phones, air conditioning, elevators and buildings with steel girders will affect toy's operation.
 - Do not leave toy or transmitter near sources of heat or under direct sunlight for long periods of time.
 - When not in use, remove the batteries from transmitter.

- BATTERY CAUTIONS**
1. For maximum performance use Alkaline batteries.
 2. Do not mix old and new batteries.
 3. Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon Zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
 4. Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
 5. Ensure batteries are inserted with the correct polarity.
 6. Remove batteries when toy is not in use.
 7. Remove exhausted batteries from toy and dispose of in accordance with the maker's recommendation.
 8. Rechargeable batteries should only be charged under adult supervision.
 9. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
 10. The antenna wires are not to be inserted into power outlets.
