Installing Batteries Into Vehicle

1-Remove driver and, using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen the screw that holds the seat in place.

2-Install 3 fresh "AA" batteries as shown. Replace seat and re-tighten screw.

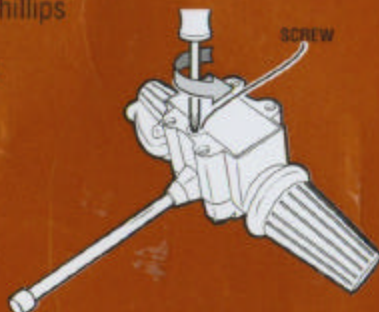
3 "AA" BATTERIES



Installing Batteries Into Remote Controller

1-Turn remote controller upside down and, using a Phillips screwdriver, loosen the screw that holds the battery cover in place.

2-Install 1 fresh 9-volt battery as shown. Replace battery cover and re-tighten screw.

Play Instructions

1-Switch button on bottom of vehicle to the "ON" position.

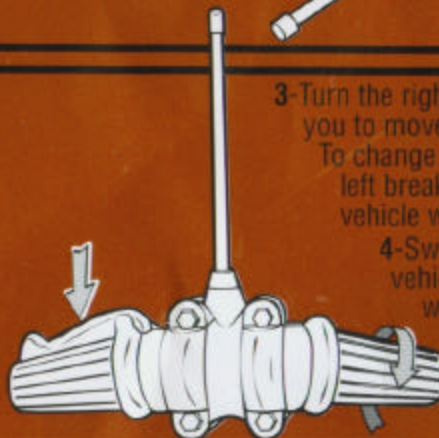


2-Place the vehicle on a smooth, flat surface.



3-Turn the right handle bar towards you to move the vehicle forward. To change direction, press the left break lever and the vehicle will spin.

4-Switch button on bottom of vehicle to the "OFF" position when through playing.
