Minimum Requirements:

To help ensure a smoother video experience on the smartphone, it's recommended that your smartphone has the following:

iOS: version 8.1 or higher.

Android: 4.1 or higher, using a device with a Graphics Processing Unit (GPU) function.

Camera Setup Steps (WiFi)

1. Please Connect the power adapter to the camera, and wait for a few moments until the camera alerts you that the "indicator lightflashes red quickly."

2. Make sure that your smartphone is connected to your wireless router (It has to be on the 2.4GHz channel if you have a dual-band router).

3. Launch the arpha app, click "Add Device", then select "Security ty&Video Surveillance", and follow the screenshot below.

4. Make sure the Red indicator on the device is blinking, then press "Next Step", ( If the operation failed, press the reset button for over 5 seconds)

5. Enter your " Wi-Fi network and password " click, " Next "

6. Scan the QR Code on your phone with camera. Heard a prompt tone.click " Next "

7. When the indicator light on the device turns from ashing red light to steady green light, the network configuration is complete

Note: Your smartphone will need to be connected to the 2.4GHz channel if you have a dual-band router.
