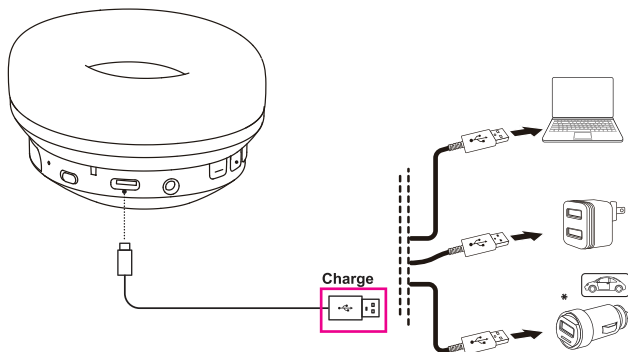

# CHARGING



Insert one end of the included **USB-C** charging cable into the charging port on your headphone.

Insert the other end into the **USB-A** port of a computer or suitable USB 5V 1A charging adapter.

(Indicator is FLASHING RED)

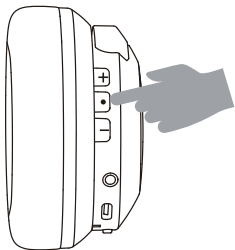


Charging (Indicator is RED)

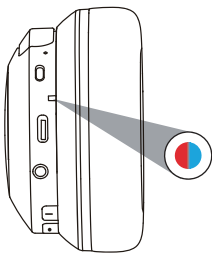


Charging Complete (Indicator is off)

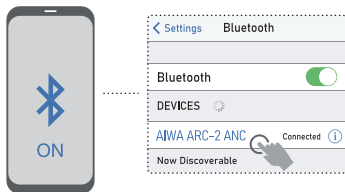
# BLUETOOTH PAIRING



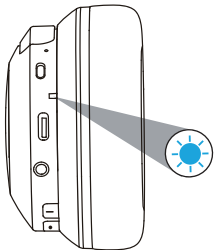
1. Press and hold the power button for about 3-5 seconds to power on or power off your headphones.



2. Once powered on, your headphones will go into pairing mode. The LED Indicator lights will flash blue and red alternately.



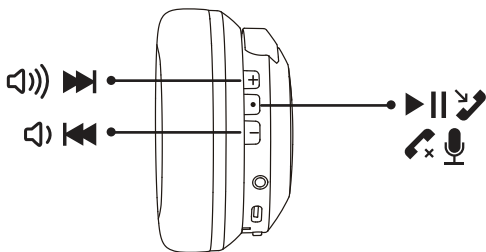
3. Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "AIWA ARC-2 ANC." Pairing window: 5 mins




4. Once paired, the LED Indicator will flash blue slowly

Noted: The headphone can connect two devices at a time, But only one device's audio can be played at a time

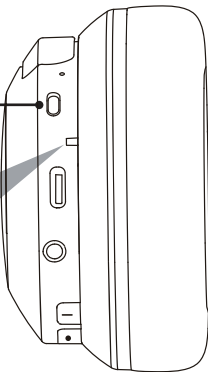

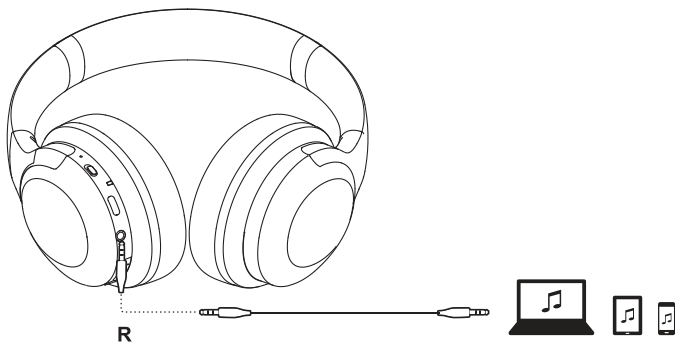

# WIRED LISTENING MODE

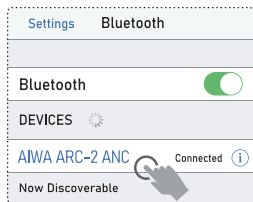


Connect one end of the included Aux cable to the Aux In port on your headphones. Connect the other end to the headphone jack on your audio device in order to listen to music using a wired connection.

You can use your headphones with a wired connection even when they are low on battery power.

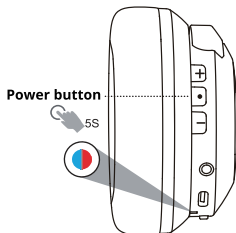
Please note that ANC and Bluetooth capabilities are disabled when there is a wired connection.

# RESET



Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Select the device listed as "AIWA ARC-2 ANC" and choose to forget the device.

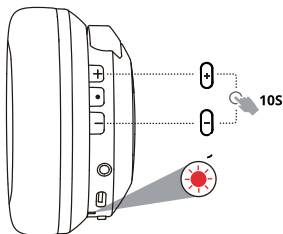
**Forget "AIWA ARC-2 ANC"**



Power off your headphones. Press and hold the power button for 5 seconds until the light flashes blue and red.

Hold the +/- buttons simultaneously for 10 seconds until you see a red light flashing 3 times.

Your headphone power OFF automatically once reset.





# SAFETY PRECAUTIONS
