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4.1.2 Test Procedure

Test method Refer as ANSI C63.10:2013

- 1. The EUT is placed on a turntable, Above 1 GHz is 1.5m and below 1 GHz is 0.8m above ground plane. The EUT Configured un accordance with ANSI C63.10, and the EUT set in a continuous mode.
- 2. The turntable shall be rotated for 360 degrees to determine the position of maximum emission level. And EUT is set 3m away from the receiving antenna, which is scanned from 1m to 4m above the ground plane to find out the highest emissions. Measurement are made polarized in both the vertical and the horizontal positions with antenna.
- 3. Span shall wide enough to full capture the emission measured. The SA from 9KHz to 26.5GHz set to the low, Mid and High channels with the EUT transmit.
- 4. No emission found between lowest internal used/generated frequency to 30MHz (9KHz~30MHz)

Although these tests were performed other than open area test site, adequate comparison measurements were confirmed against 30 m open are test site. Therefore sufficient tests were made to demonstrate that the alternative site produces results that correlate with the ones of tests made in an open field based on KDB 414788.
