

SHIRT CRAWLING

For Lithium-ion Batteries:

- · Charge battery in isolated area.
- Never charge battery unattended.
- Keep from flammable materials.






* Remy/Emile is operated by 1 x 3.7V 150 mAh Lithium-ion rechargeable

For Lithium-ion Batteries:

Recharging Remy/Emile:

- Plug the Micro USB Cable into the Micro USB port on Remy/Emile and connect to a power source as indicated in the diagram.
- 2. Charging is indicated by a flashing red light.
- 3. When fully charged, the light on Remy/Emile will appear stop flashing.



Installing or changing batteries in Cheese Control:

Lay Cheese Control down so that the battery compartment faces upwards. Cheese Control requires 3x1.5V "LR44/AG13" Button Cell Batteries (included).

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- 1. Remove the screw to access the battery compartment.
- 2. Open battery door.
- 3. Exhausted batteries are to be removed.
- 4. New batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Replace the battery door and secure with screw.

BATTERY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc), or rechargable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Non-rechargable batteries are not to be recharged.
- The supply terminals are not to be short circuited.
- Do not use rechargable batteries.
- Remove batteries when not in use or discharged
