Appendix B

Duty Cycle Correction During 100msec

Each function key sends a different series of characters, but each packet period (43.5msec) never exceeds a series of long or short (5msec) pules. Assuming any combination of short and long pules may be obtained due to encoding the worse case transmit duty cycle would be considered 5 per 43.5msec=11.5% duty cycle. Figure A through C show the characteristics of the pulse train for one of these function.




Rear View of the product
