To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to inform you of our request to dismiss the application for a FCC grant for our transmitter with FCC ID: CFS8DL5800RP2 (Grant date 08/02/2016). The reason for this request is to allow Honeywell to resubmit the device for certification under the same FCC ID, with an increased RF gain.

This device is not yet in production, and thus it has never been sold in the United States or elsewhere.

Our engineering department recently decided this device's initial release to sales should be with a higher RF gain setting if possible, for improved range. The design change needed for this is a change to the RF gain setting in firmware. Hardware is unchanged. RF lab emissions measurements with samples reprogrammed to the new gain have been taken, and the lab report has been issued

Honeywell has initiated the effort to make this change with our TCB, American Certification Body, and has prepared an updated set of TCB application documents.
