
USER'S MANUAL(English)

Multi-function / 4in1 Wireless Stereo Headphone

(1) Product indication



- 1- U Power on /off
- 2- |||/ Play/pause,answer/end calls,reject call,last number redial,search for FM station
- 3- Volume up(Long Press)/Next song(Short Press)
- 4- Volume down(Long Press)/Last song(Short Press)
- 5- **M** MP3/FM
- 6- Headset jack
- 7- LED indicator
- 8- Micro USB charging port
- 9- Microphone
- 10- Micro SD/TF card slot

(2) Power on/off the headset

- Power on:Slide the switch right and the blue and red indicator light will flash.
- Power off: Slide the switch left and indicator light will go off.

(3) Pair to your mobile phone or other products

- Slide the switch right and the blue and red indicator light will flash.
- Turn on the BT function of your phone or other products.
- Search for the BT devices and select'JH-812'.(Enter the code '0000' if needed)
- If paring is successful the blue light indicator starts flashing.
- The headphone remembers the current device and will connect it automatically
- in the next time (Please make sure the BT function of your phone is working)
 If the pairing is not successful, please switch off headset firstly, and then re-pair again.

(4) MP3/FM

- In power-on mode, short press button, FM radio will play automatically.
 Long press the cutton to search all radio stations automatically, wait for a moment, then short press cut on pr

(5) Answer/end call,reject call,last number redial(In the BT mode)

- Answer/End call: when there is a call, short press ► | // C button to answer the coming call. After the call, press ► | // C button to hang up. If the other side hang up, no need to press the ► | | // C button.
- Reject call: long press ►||/C button about 2-3seconds
- Last number redial: press ► button 2 times continuously
- When calling, the music will pause automatically if the BT headphone is playing music, After hang up, the music will continue to play automatically.

(6) Charging the headset

- Insert USB charging cable into USB port which supports 5V power (such as AC/DC
 USB adapter or PC USB port). When the red light is on, the headset is in charging.
 The red light will be off when the headset is fully charged. It takes about 3 hours
 to charge the headset fully.
- The battery is rechargeable. Low-Voltage alert:when the alert tone 'low battery' sounds ,the headset needs to be charged as soon as possible. First time charging a please be sure the battery has been charged fully before use.

(7) Wired headphone function

For any mode of headphone, you can connect one side of 3.5 stereo sound supply extension line to headphone audio jack, the another side connect to audio jack (such as mobile phone, computer, Ipad etc). Then you will hear songs from other devices.
