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
#### 1. INTRODUCTION

• For power spectral density (PSD) measurements on all devices,

Array Gain =  $10 \log (N_{ANT}/N_{SS}) dB = 3.01$ ;

• For power measurements on IEEE 802.11 devices,

Array Gain = 0 dB for  $N_{ANT} \le 4$ ;

If antenna gains are not equal, Directional gain may be calculated by using the formulas applicable to equal gain antennas with G<sub>ANT</sub> set equal to the gain of the antenna having the highest gain.

Note 2: The EUT also supports Beamforming mode, and the Beamforming support 802.11n/ac/ax, not include 802.11a/b/g. The directional gain =  $G_{ANT}$  + Array Gain (3.01dBi).

Note 3: Antenna type and antenna gain are provided by the manufacturer.

Where

Pd = power density in mW/cm<sup>2</sup>

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

r = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd is the limit of MPE, 1mW/cm<sup>2</sup>. If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

The max Power Density at R (20 cm) = 0.2381mW/cm2 + 0.1666mW/cm2 = 0.4047mW/cm2< 1mW/cm2.

So the safety distance is 20cm for device installed without any other radio equipment.
