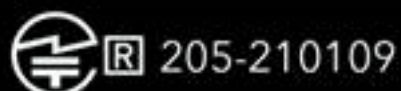

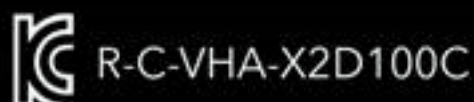

B. Access to the required information on the e-label

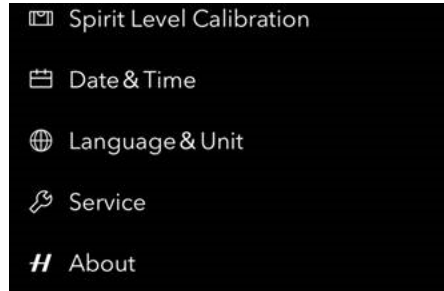
To check the compliance information, make sure that the camera is powered on

Step 1: go to the Main Menu

Step 2: tap the General Settings icon on the Touch Display



Step 3: swipe through the list, and select About.



After step 3 end user can access the FCC ID and IC ID



Remark: Users must be able to access the regulatory information without requiring special access codes or permissions, and in all cases the information must be accessible in no more than three steps from a product's main or home menu
