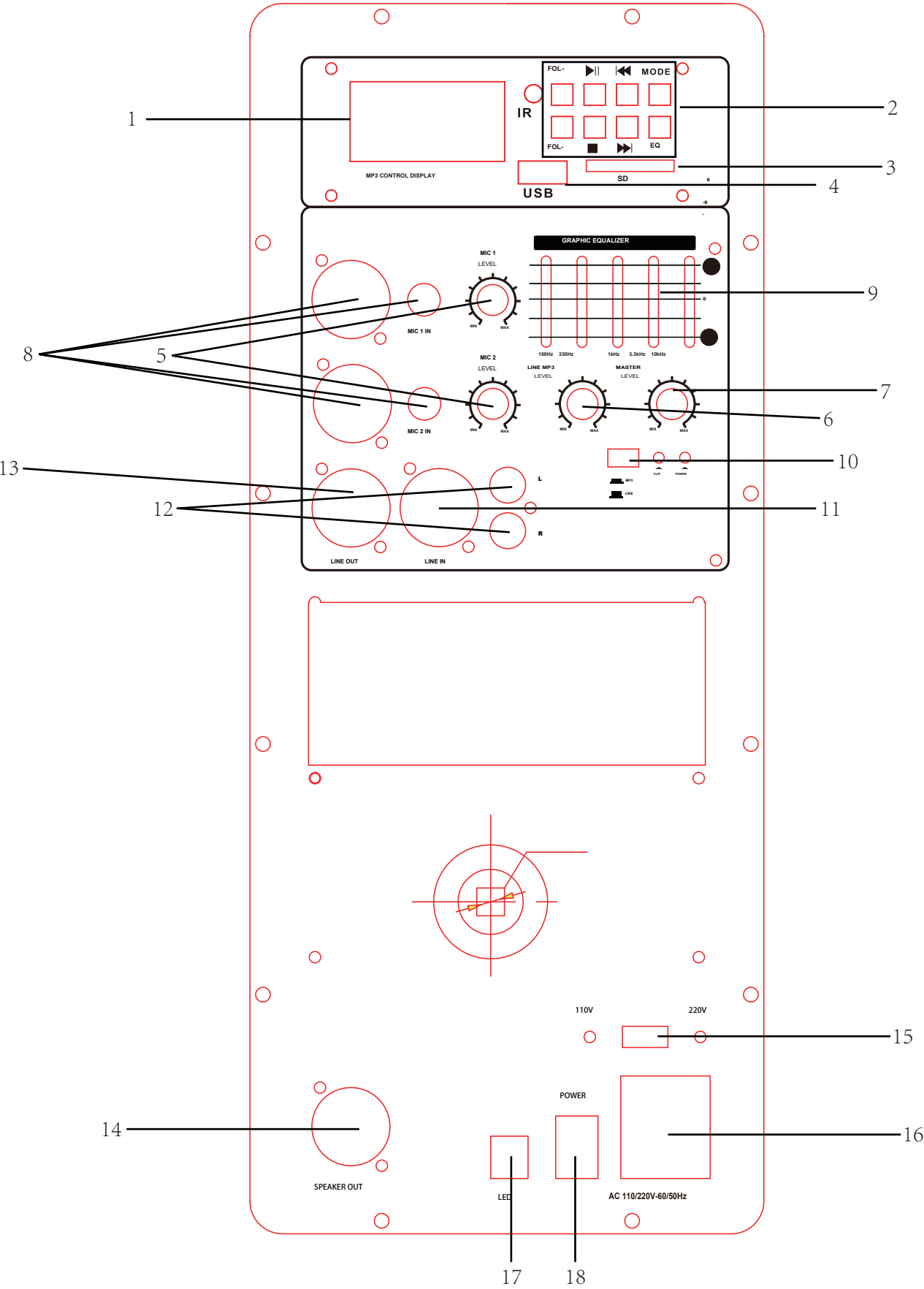

OPERATION

- 1.Prior to switching on, turn volume down to minimum.
- 2.Connect the audio source to the appropriate Input socket.
- 3.Another Speaker can be connected to the output socket, so that several boxes can be daisy chained.
- 4.Connect to the mains supply.
- 5.Switch on the audio source, followed by the active speaker.
- 6.Set the volume with the applicable control.
- 7.Adjust the bass+treble.
- 8.Activate the Bluetooth:Input password"0000"if ask for.
