



Fault	Possible causes and Countermeasures
When the organ power is turned on or off, there is a murmur.	This is a normal phenomenon, indicating that the current enters the time.
When using a mobile phone, there is noise.	The use of mobile phones near produces will produce the machine at this radiation. To avoid this, turn off the mobile phone or use it away from the organ.
There is no sound when playing the keyboard or playing music.	Verify that there are other devices connected to the PHONES/OUTPUT Jack. If headphones are plugged into the Jack at this time, no sound will be made.
The selected timbre is not pronounced properly, or the volume is too low.	Verify that the following settings are appropriate: main volume, double tone balance.
Abnormal sound of timbre or rhythm.	The AC voltage is on the low side.
Some timbre is distorted.	The volume knob is too large and should be open at a position less than 3/4.
The accompaniment is not pronounced properly.	Make sure the accompaniment volume is set to the appropriate level.
It seems that all timbre is pronounced, or the pronunciation seems to be cut off.	The maximum simultaneous pronunciation of this organ is 64 notes. If the dual tone mode is in use and the accompaniment or music is being played again, some notes/sounds in the accompaniment/music will be default.
Under the same time color, the quality of notes is different from that of notes.	This is a normal phenomenon. The wooden machine adopts AVM sound source mode, which is segmented sampling and recording in the whole key field, so the sound quality of the two notes is slightly different.

## Smoke, odour, overheat

If the instrument smokes, stinks or overheats, there is a risk of fire and electric shock when the instrument continues to be used. In the event of the above, the following actions should be performed immediately.

1. Switch it off.

2. Please unplug the alternating current transformer from the power outlet.

3. Contact your dealer.

## Alternating current transformer

Improper use of alternating current transformers may cause fire and electric shock. The following considerations must be observed.

The special AC transformer specified for this product must be used.

At AC power supply with an output voltage within the rated voltage range marked on the AC transformer must be used.

Power sockets and power extension lines should not be overloaded.

The power cord of AC transformer is improperly dealt with, resulting in damage or fracture, resulting in fire and electric shock risk. The following considerations must be observed.

Do not place or heat heavy objects on the power cord.

Do not try to modify or bend the power cord too much.  
Do not twist or pull the power cord.

If the power cord or plug is damaged, replace the same type of power cord and plug.

Do not touch alternating current transformer with wet hand, otherwise there is a risk of electric shock.

Please use alternating current transformer where water will not be splashed. Water is dangerous causing fire and electric shock.

Do not place vases or any other containers containing water on AC transformer. Water is in danger of causing fire and electric shock.

## Alternating current transformer

Improper use of alternating current transformers may cause fire and electric shock. The following considerations must be observed.

Do not place the power cord next to the furnace or near other heat sources.

Do not pull the power cord when unplugged from the power outlet. The plug body of AC transformer must be grasped.



The AC transformer must be plugged into the power outlet to the end.

In the event of thunderstorms or before traveling or leaving for a long time, the AC transformer should be unplugged from the power outlet on the wall.

The AC transformer should be removed from the wall at least once a year. Unplug the power outlet and clean the dust accumulated around the plug.

## Don't burn this product

## Function description:

Keyboard: 88 standard keys(including black key). Range: A1 ~ C9.

Recording and playback function, transpose function, accompaniment volume adjustment function, double keyboard/double tone function, chord/dynamics function.

Hardware: 64 Chord, with 2-way 16-bit DAC output, built-in power amplifier circuit.

## Operations

### Play (Timbre) mode:

automatically enters play (Timbre) mode when the computer is switched on.

Press [ + ], [ - ] can choose up and down to play Timbre.

Press and hold [ + ], [ - ] key more than 1 second, you can choose up and down Timbre 0-127 continuously.

### Rhythm Mode:

Press the "start/stop" button/"Rhythm" button, the system enters rhythm mode and plays one of "rhythms".

Press [ + ], [ - ] can choose the "rhythm" from 0-127.

Press the "+/-" button more than 1 second, you can quickly select the rhythm and let go to play the corresponding rhythm.

In this mode, press the tone button, then press the +/- key to change the tone. To change the rhythm, need to press the rhythm key.

### Demo Mode:

Press [ Demo ] key, system will play all demos, press [ start/stop ] key to stop demo to play.

Press [ + ], [ - ] key to select demo, track from 0-29

Hold [ + ], [ - ] key more than 1 second, you can quickly select the Demo, release your hand and start playing the corresponding demo.

In this mode, press the Tone key, and then press the +/- key to change the tone color. To change the Demo, need to press the Demo key.

## Recording related functions:

Press the [ recording ] key, you can enter recording mode, digital LED display [ REC ].

Recording function is to take multi-channel real-time recording mode to record the notes.

After entering the recording mode, the user can play the keys at will, the system will automatically record the key notes played by the user, when the recording block of the system is full, the digital tube will display the [ FULL ] prompt the record full.

Press the playback key to realize the recording playback function. However, this playback function is considered effective only when a note is recorded, at the end of playback, the original state will be automatically returned to the original state.

During playback process, you can choose to play back the tone color.

After re-recording and system reset, the recording note will be refreshed automatically.

## Chord/Dynamics mode system:

During the playing rhythm, Short Press [ chord/dynamics ] key and release to enter Chord mode.

Chord Function: A3 ~ F#4 Interval to play the keys, will play with the rhythm of the Chord, and the pitch of the Chord changes with the pitch of the key.

In chord mode, short press [ chord/dynamics ] key and release will close the chord.

The long press on the [ chord/dynamics ] key and doesn't release to open or close the dynamics at any time, digital Tube display [ DYN ] or [ OFF ], boot the default is open.

## Double keyboard/double voice mode:

Short press [ double keyboard/double voice ] key and loose to open or close the double keyboard mode, digital LED display [ SPA ] or [ OFF ].

The range of keys in dual keyboard mode will be divided into two ranges: A2-B5 and C4-C8.

Long Press [ dual keyboard/dual tone ] key and does not loose to open or close the dual voice mode, digital LED display [ SPA ] or [ OFF ].

In Dual Voice mode will play the current tone (foreground) + piano tone (background) combination.

In the Dual voice mode, press the Tone key, and then press the +/- key to switch the foreground.

## Bluetooth Feature:

Bluetooth Search on Mobile Phone; Bluetooth Name: GZJT-MUSIC connection can play Mobile Phone Audio.

When playing Bluetooth audio, press "start/stop" key to pause the song, and press again will keep playing the song.

Press "+" or "-" to choose the previous song or next song.

## USB/MIDI function:

Connect the computer or tablet via USB cable for multimedia interaction.

Or download the bubble piano APP without plugging in the data cable. And choose Bluetooth connection to practice with the piano.

## Fall or impact:
