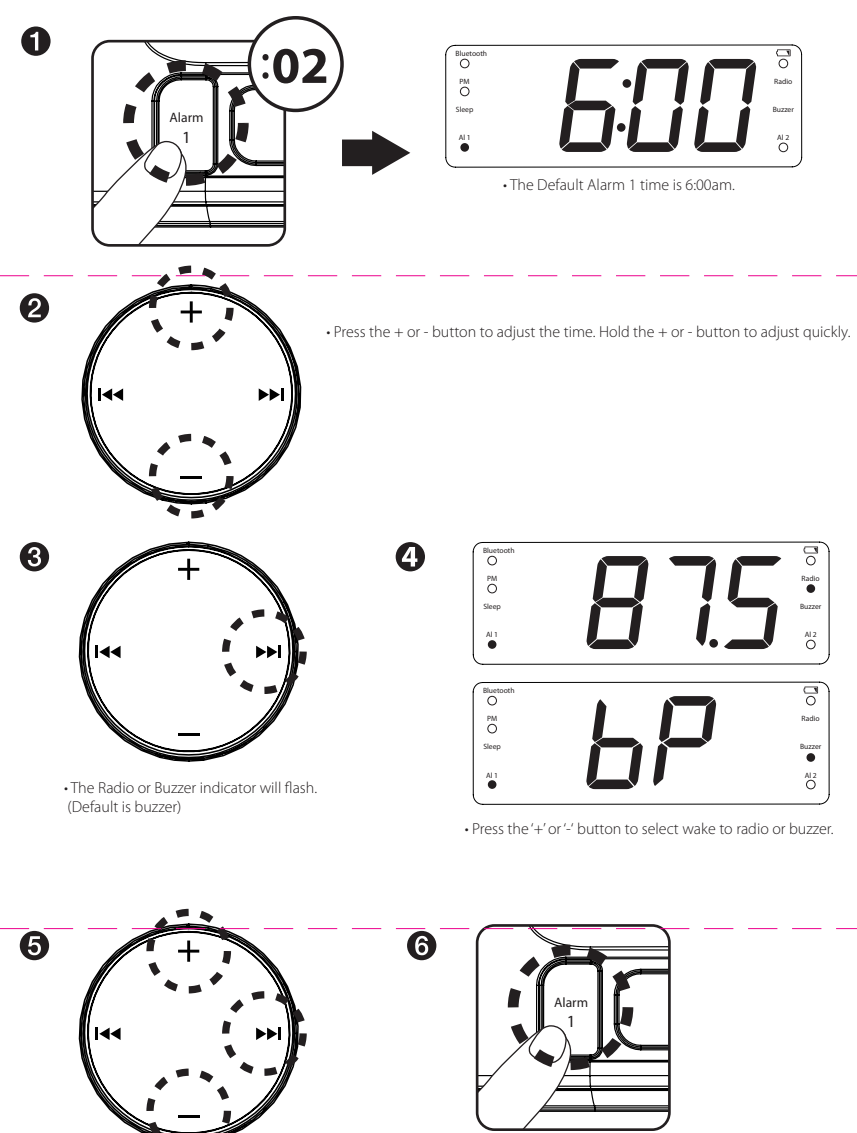

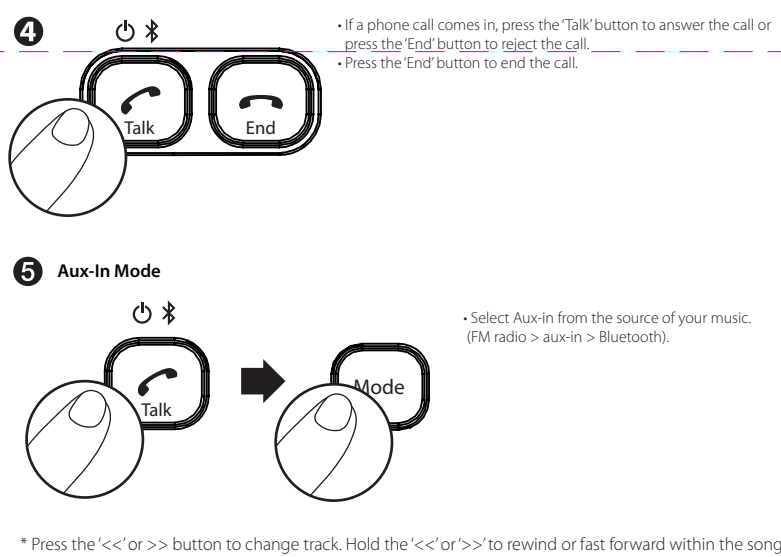
• Anytime you press the End button you save the settings and exit.

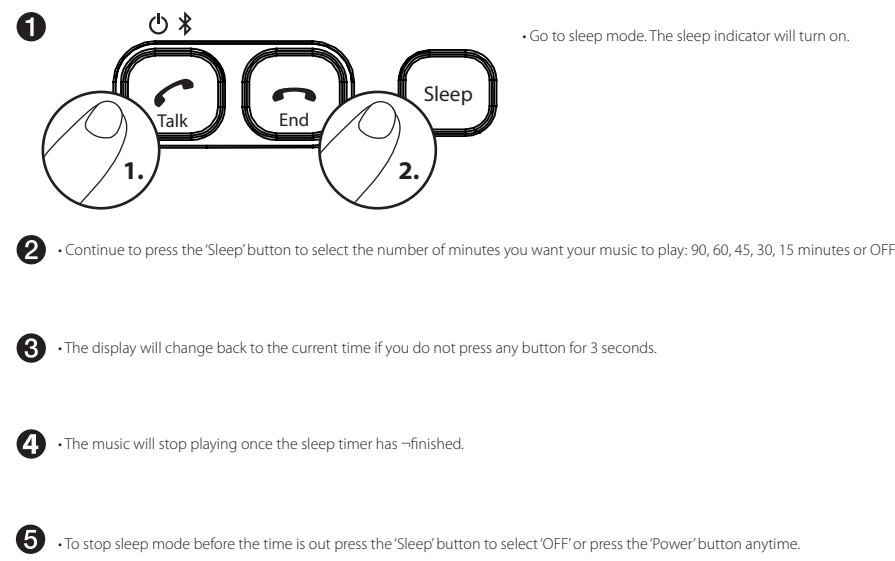


* Press the '<<' or '>>' button to change track. Hold the '<<' or '>>' to rewind or fast forward within the song

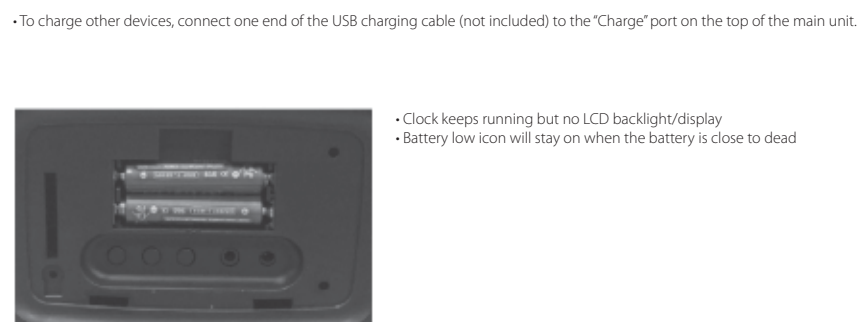
