




1. For first-time use, remove the insulation stickers on the earbuds.

- 2. Return earbuds to the charging case. 3.Take out the earbuds or hold the Multi-function
- 4.Once paired automatically, the LED indicator of the master earphone will flash red and blue alternately; The sub-earphone flashes a blue light every 3s.A voice
- prompt will say "Pairing". 5.Select "EP03" on your phone to connect from the Bluetooth
- Note: Earbuds will turn off automatically after 5 minutes if they have not been paired with any device.

WEARING



- 1.Gently clamp the earbuds onto the upper part of your auricles. Make sure the front side (Sound Outlet) faces your ear canal and the back side with touch control rests behind your ear. 2. Move the earbuds upwards or downwards until the earbuds fit securely and
- you can hear the sound well. 3. Dust, earwax or other debris will accumulate in the earplugs. In order to maintain the best sound quality, please gently clean the earplugs with a cotton swab regularly.
