After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) Is there a schematic available for the TX board or is this an OEM part? If it is an OEM part, please provide a parts list that shows this, if not then please provide the schematic for it.
- 2) If a parts list is to be provided, please let us know if confidentiality is requested on it, and update the confidentiality letter as necessary.
- 3) The test report shows either the Chase Bilog or Schwarzbeck Biconical antenna being used (page 8). Both of these antenna's have an AF of about 13-17 dB/m at 27 MHz depending on actual calibration. The test report only shows an AF of 6.20 at the fundamental frequency. Please explain.
