TWS Wireless Pairing

1. Turn on two F21 speakers.
2. Disconnect all devices with F21 speakers.
3. Double click the power button " on the one of speaker into TWS pairing mode.

5. Click the device name "F21" to pair on.(Refer to page 2 "Wireless connection")

Alexa Connection

1. Disconnect wireless speaker with all devices.
2. Put your wireless device in pairing mode.
3. Open the Alexa app, click the "Settings".
4. Click Echo Dot device name.
5. Click the "Wireless".
6. Click the speaker name "F21" to pair the wireless speaker with Alexa.
