- 1. Quickly short press Button R and L to switch menus or return
- 3. Short press M button enter into current menu

Button function instruction for Tennis

- 1. Short press "M "button to turn on the device , stop game
- 2. In scoreboard mode, short press M button to quickly switch between "Scoreboard mode", "Game mode", "Set mode" to see the game score and set only score only in larger easy to read digits
- 3. In scorboard mode, double press M button to quickly check game and match data record
- 4. Short press L (P1) or R (P2) button to add game points
- 5. Triple press M button to reset current game
- 6. Triple press L or R button to reverse game points
- 6. Press M button 4 times directly to return back to tier 1 menu from scoreboard interface 7. Long-press M button to turn off device
- 8. Long press L or R button to activate Server Icon to begin play. The SimpleScore™ scoring system will not record the score untill server has been selected
- 9. Note at end of each game, You have 10 seconds to recall the last point with a triple press, after that time it is logged into the game statistics and cannot be edited within the device

BLUETOOTH PAIRING

- 1. Turn on two The SimpleScore™ devices.
- 2. Navigate to the Bluetooth option in Tier 2.
- 3. Select Bluetooth ON both devices.
- 4. When the Bluetooth icon stops blinking, the devices are connected.

Note: Only 2 The SimpleScore[™] devices can connect simultaneously.



DATA TRANSFER

- 1. Connect the device to your computer or phone via the included USB Type-C cable.
 - 2. Android/iPhone: File appears in the Files app > Downloads
 - 3. PC: File appears as a USB drive. Open to view or copy file.
 - 4. Rename and date the file, save, convert to Excel as needed.



GAME TIME CLOCK

- 1. Game time starts automatically with first point played.
- 2. Automatically stops at game end.
- 3. Total game time is saved in match stats.



ADHESION INSTRUCTIONS (TENNIS)

1. Attach the Device:

Center the device at the base of the strings just above the frame. Press the dampener down into the strings, hooking the first connection under the string and the following connection over the strings, placing pressure on the base of the device to snap it into place. (Do not put pressure directly on the screen)

2. Device Removal:

Push down the end string connector then pinch it up in between the strings and peel the Dampener off.



ADHESION INSTRUCTIONS (PICKLEBALL)

1. Prepare the Paddle:

Clean the base of your paddle just above the handle.

2. Peel Adhesive: Remove the protective film from the double-sided tape on the bottom of the SimpleScore™ plastic

3. Attaching the Housing:

Carefully center and place the device at the cleaned area and press firmly to attach.

Note: Once placed in the housing, the device cannot be removed Recharging and downloading are done right from your paddle.



HOUSING REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS (PICKLEBALL)

- 1. Using a blow dryer and plastic scraper housing can be removed without damaging the paddle.
- 2. Aim the blow dryer on medium to high heat at the base of the housing for 30-60 seconds.
- 3. Carefully work the scraper under the housing while aiming blow dryer in the same direction.
- 4. Use rubbing alcohol swab to remove any remaining residue.



CHARGING THE DEVICE

- 1. Use the provided USB-C cable to connect the device to a USB power adapter.
- 2. Plug the adapter into any standard household outlet.
- 3. Charge with any laptop or PC using the USB connector.
- **4.** Charging will begin automatically 2 hours recharge time.
- 5. Battery life 8-16 hours.



BATTERY SAFETY

- 1. Only charge using the included USB-C cable and a certified USB power adapter.
- 2. Do not expose the device to water, fire, or extreme temperatures.
- 3. Do not attempt to open the device or modify the battery.

TROUBLESHOOTING

ISSUE	POSSIBLE CAUSE	SOLUTION
Device won't turn on	Battery is depleted	Recharge the device using the included USB-C cable
Buttons not responding	System glitch or unresponsive state	Press and hold the M button for 5–10 seconds to force a restart
Bluetooth not connecting	Devices are not in pairing mode or are out of range	Ensure both devices are powered on, Bluetooth is enabled, and they are within 10 feet of each other
Bluetooth icon keeps blinking	Connection not established	Turn both devices off and back on, then repeat the Bluetooth pairing steps
Device not detected by computer or phone	USB cable not properly connected, faulty cable, or USB port issue	Check the connection, try a different USB port, or use another USB-C cable
Data not showing in USB folder	USB cable not properly connected, faulty cable, or USB port issue	Check the connection, try a different USB port, or use another USB-C cable
Device falls off paddle	Surface wasn't cleaned properly tape not fully bonded	Clean the mounting area thoroughly and reapply the device with firm pressure; replace the tape if needed
