

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

#### 1. Wireless Charging Function:

- Once connected the LED indicator will flash WHITE once indicating the device is in standby mode and is ready to begin charging.
- Place the wireless charging supported device on the charging surface(1),the device will begin to charge automatically. (LED will glow WHITE when device is charging).
- \*\* Note: When wireless charging, if the LED indicators flashing the device is either NOT a wireless charging device or there is an object between the device and charging surface interfering with the charging process.



#### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- WARNING-When using this product, basic precautions should always be followed:
- 1. Read all the instructions before use.
- Never store or use this product in temperatures below 32°F (0°C) or above 115°F (45°C).
