Reaction/answers to the questions:


1. You are correct that use is restricted to the Compaq laptops, but the Modular Approval questionnaire DA001407 does not ask question about this kind of limitation. We expect that on grant the tested laptops will not be shown but that it is general for Compaq laptops.
- 2a. The transmitter can be taken off from the laptop and put on any other Compaq laptop that has the USB connector. Therefore we think that label on transmitter is sufficient.
- 2b. This product will also be used in many other countries and thus the label will have to accommodate room for other approval numbers too. Therefore we thought it better to have only the FCC ID on the label and the rest of required text in the manual/flyer.

The connector you see on the photos is only for production test purposes.

It is not intended to use external antennae with this device and the plastic case will not be modified to allow access to the connector. The Block Diagram Description has been changed accordingly.

4. The antennae are on the pc-board and thus there is no point on cable loss etc.
The reports have been changed with remark on the pre-amp factors in the measurements in section 1.4. Rev1 version of reports will be sent to the file.
5. We sent you first draft of the manual and forgot the flyer; this flyer contains the regulatory information and includes the statement on RF Exposure and on unauthorized modifications.
