Step2. Insert the batteries as shown inside the battery compartment.


Step3. Replace the cover.

USB + PS/2 Mode installation

The receiver is connected to your computer via USB port.



JSB Port

- 1. Connect the USB plug to USB port of your computer.
- Connect the PS/2 plug of the USB + PS/2 Adaptor to Green PS/2 port your computer.

CAUTION:

Windows 98 or higher or Macintosh OS 8.6 or higher is required for USB port installation. Connect the receiver cable to the USB port on computer.
