To avoid electric shock and fire, do not allow water, liquid or any flammable detergent to get into or to clean the product.</div> <div>2. Do not spray insecticide, perfume or other flammable spray around the products.</div> <div>3. Before connecting the power supply, please check whether the voltage of the product is consistent with the local power supply voltage.</div> <div>4. This product can not replace normal ventilation, daily dust collection or oil pumping when cooking.</div> <div>5. Ensure the product is used in condition of a stable and horizontal level.</div> <div>6. Leave at least 30cm of space on the back and sides of the product, and at least 50cm of space above the product when using.</div> <div>7. Ensure both the filter and its cover are properly installed before using.</div> <div>8. 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<div> <div>FUNCTION INSTRUCTION</div> <div>When connect to the power socket, the buzzer will ring for 1 second. The machine enters the pre-processing mode (the light ring will change in blue, cyan, green, yellow, red, purple, and after 30 seconds of pre-processing, the color corresponding to the current air quality will be displayed.)</div> <div> <div>Button Operation</div> <div> <div>Power Button</div> <div>① Touch the power button to turn on the machine, the buzzer will ring for one time, and the High mode of wind speed indicator lights on.</div> <div>② Touch the button again, the buzzer will ring for one time and the machine will turn off with all lights turn off.</div> </div> <div> <div>Wind Speed Button</div> <div> <div>① In the condition of working, press the wind speed button, the buzzer will ring for one time, the wind speed will cycle between Sleep-High-Auto, and the corresponding indicator light will be white.</div> <div>② When turn to Sleep, the fan will run at low wind speed; when turn to High, the fan will run at high wind speed. When turn to Auto, the wind speed will automatically adjust according to air quality.</div> <div>③ When the air quality is poor, the wind speed is automatically adjusted to the high mode, and the light ring will display red color; When the air quality is normal, the wind speed is automatically adjusted to the mid mode, the light ring will display yellow color; When the air quality is excellent, the wind speed is automatically adjusted to the low mode, and the light ring will display blue color.</div> </div> </div> </div> </div>	<div> <div>06</div> <div>07</div> </div>														
<div> <div>Smart Operation Instruction</div> <div> <div>Works with smart life APP</div> <div> <div>1.Download &amp; Registration</div> <div> <div>• Scan the QR code to download "Smart Life" APP. You can also search "Smart Life" in either APP store or Google Play to install the APP.</div> <div>• Open the "Smart Life" APP, tap "Register" to register a "Smart Life" account with your phone number or E-mail. Then sign in the APP.</div> </div> <div> <div></div> </div> </div> <div> <div>2.Add Devices in Easy Mode (Recommend)</div> <div> <div>Make sure your smart device is energized and your mobile phone is connected to your WIFI network. If the WiFi indicator of smart device keeps flashing to indicate that the smart device enters the mode of configuring the mobile phone; if not, please press the Timer button for more than 5 seconds, after hearing the smart devices "beep", then loose it and this means the device is already for configuration.</div> <div>• Open your "Smart Life" APP and tap "+" on the top right of the APP. Select type of service device, tap "All devices" and turn to "Add Device", then automatically fetch the password of the WiFi network that your mobile phone connects to. <div> <div>d. Make sure the connected devices have not reached the maximum number of WiFi router. If not, please disconnect the network of some devices.</div> <div>e. Make sure password of the WiFi network is correct when adding new device.</div> <div>f. Make sure you have not used any Chinese Characters to name your WiFi network.</div> <div>(2) Can I control device with 2G/3G/4G/5G network?</div> <div>When adding device for the first time, it requires that your mobile phone and device are connected to the same WiFi network. After adding device successfully, you can remote control your device with 2G/3G/4G/5G network.</div> <div>(3) How can I share my device with others?</div> <div>Open your Smart Life APP, select your device and tap the button in the top right corner. Tap "Shared devices" and "Add sharing", then select the "county/region" where the account belongs to and input the "Account number"(s phone number or an E-mail address) you want to share with. (Please make sure the phone number or E-mail is registered.)</div> <div>(4) How can I manager the device shared by others?</div> <div>Open your Smart Life and you can operate the device by tapping the product in the "Shared device I received" on the home page.</div> <div>(5) How to remove device?</div> <div>Method 1: Press the Power button for more than 7 seconds, you will hear "beep", it means the device is removed, and the WiFi indicator light begin to flash quickly again.</div> <div>Method 2: Open your "Smart Life" APP, select your device and tap the button in the top right corner. Tap "More".Then tap the "Remove Device" in the bottom, the WiFi indicator light begin to flash quickly again.</div> </div>	<div> <div>MAINTENANCE</div> <div> <div>Note</div> <div> <div>• Ensure the machine is unplugged before maintenance.</div> <div>• Do not immerse the air purifier into water or any liquid.</div> <div>• Do not use abrasive, corrosive or flammable cleansers (such as bleach or alcohol) to clean any part of the unit.</div> <div>• Do not wash the filter.</div> <div>• Do not use a vacuum cleaner to clean the filter.</div> <div>• Please sterilize the filter under sunlight regularly.</div> </div> <div> <div>Cleaning &amp; Storage</div> <div> <div>① Ensure the machine is power-off and unplugged.</div> <div>② Use a soft cloth with neutral cleanser to clean away any dust or debris from the surface of the machine and air inlet/outlet.</div> <div>③ After the machine completely dry out, put on the bag and place it in a cool and well-ventilated place.</div> <div>④ If you do not use it for a long time, please turn on the machine for a few minutes from time to time to ensure a good performance.</div> <div>Notice: Please don't drop any water into the machine when clean the air outlet.</div> </div> </div> </div> </div>														
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
